When corn is in checks with straight rows both ways, something is gained by running the cultivator from one corner of the field to the other.

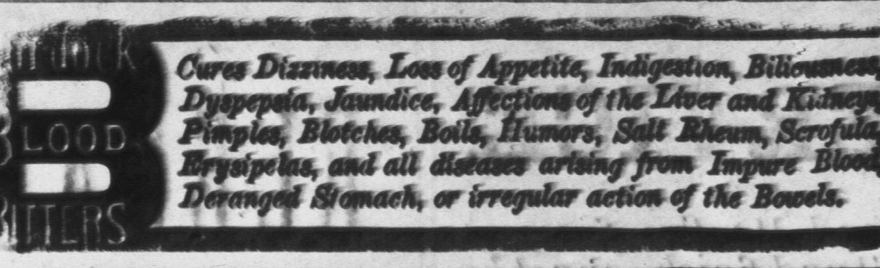
