Matthew Donaldson.

The name of Matthew Donaldson, the hardy pioneer preacher and backwoods missionary, will ever be recalled by the early homesteaders in Chippewa county.

No person could have done more to merit the love and gratitude of the people with whom he was associated during the trying circumstances which attended the settlement of the early immigrants into any wild, unsettled country.

Matthew Donaldson was born in Northumberland Co., England, and emigrated to Canada in 1861. During his stay in that country, he lived the greater part of his time in Durham and Victoria Co's.

At different times he took charge of a field of labor in the townships of Mansvelt, Capton, Clarke, Darlington, Cantwright, Somerville, Verulam and Fenelon.

He lived in Somerville township about twenty miles north of the town of Lindsay and near the village of Boboyegon.

He came to Michigan, May 20, 1876, and settled on a homestead about 12 miles south of Sault Ste. Marie, east of the meridian at a place then known as Sand Hill, but since known as Donaldson. The first summer and winter were spent in getting a home prepared, but while thinking of the necessities of life for himself and family he was mindful of the spiritual wants of the families which had already settled in the place.

The people had many pressing wants but the most urgent of them all was religious worship, and a spiritual adviser. Mr. Donaldson felt called upon to tender his services. He was welcomed by every religious persuasion. His mission was one of love and it knew no creed save "Peace on earth and good will toward men."
