TAX EXEMPTIONS.

In the local legislature Dr. Ryerson has introduced a bill to abolish exemption of church property from taxation. This is a move, to THE WARDER'S mind, in the right direction.

The custom of exempting church property from taxation dates back to the dark ages when so much was controlled by the negative forces of the universe. Long anterior to the rise of the papacy in the dark ages the church had obtained "by concealment or connivance, certain immovable estates, the revenues of which were applicable to their ewn maintenance." After the conversion of Constantine in the 4th century, edicts were issued, under clerical influence over that mperor, permitting persons to bequeath property to the church. Within fifty years, in 370, the abuse of this became sepatent that an edict was issued prohibiting the clergy from receiving the gifts or bequests of women; thus illustrating that bequests of women; thus illustrating that from the very beginning of the organized church in the 4th century the clergy understood where their "bread was but-
