The work will be carried out in the best manner known to the photographic, engraving and printing arts. Every locality and section of the Dominion will be fully and splendidly represented, that the possessor of the completed work may truly feel that he has within its compass as thorough and complete an acquaintance with Canada as if he had spent years in travelling over it. The pictures will be accompanied by accurate descriptions of the subjects presented, and the object is not less to instruct the mind than to please the eye. This, then, is the purpose of "Canada," and if its accomplishment be carried out with the fidelity and completeness with which we hope to endow it, it will be a work of permanent merit and of great national as well as artistic value.
