Russian Railway through Manchuria.

London, May 8.—The United Press correspondent in St. Petersburg says he learns from a high source that Russia has a separate understanding with China. This understanding does not cede Manchurian territory wholly to Russia, but it places it under Russian control to the extent of allowing Russia when so disposed to bring the Siberian railroad from Nertschinsk, through the valleys of the Nonni and Singari, in the Kirin province, to Broughton Bay, in the Sea of Japan.

Illegally Detained in Nunneries.

Sedalia, Mo., May 7.—The following resolution has been unanimously passed by the Christian Endeavour convention, in session here: "Whereas, in various places in the State of Missouri for many years the constitution of the United States has been violated, and civil liberty outraged, in that helpless girls and women have been illegally and cruelly held in a condition of slavery in prison houses not recognized by the law of the land, viz., nunneries, reformatories, and convents; now, therefore, we, representatives of the Christian Endeavour Societies of the Christian church of Missouri, 14,000 strong, do most earnestly request the Governor of Missouri to recommend legislation which shall prevent the unwarranted arrest and detention of any person whatever in this State. We further request the general assembly of Missouri to enact said laws, to the end that the grievous wrongs be summarily stopped."
