Political Notes.

In North Ontario the policy of free trade struck the toboggan slide. At last it is possible to locate the exodus. It is from the liberal party.

McCarthyism and fanaticism now lie buried in the same grave in North Ontario. Free trade has been abandoned with disgust by every continental nation that ever tried it.

Protection affords employment to the consumers who are the best customers of the Canadian farmer.

About the only thing the liberals developed while in office was a tendency to add enormously to the public debt.

"Don't know McShane" will soon become as important in the liberal declaration of principles as "Don't know Snider."

No protection to the farmer is the policy promulgated by the patrons in North Ontario. Clearly, they and the liberals are in the same boat.

The cheap beef of Chicago would drive Canadian producers out of their home market under the liberal policy of free trade.

The campaign of deception and distrust received its answer in North Ontario conservative, 2,649 votes; liberal, 1,090 votes.

The railway mileage of Canada in 1875 was 4,826 miles, and in 1894 it was 16,627, yet Sir Rieu and Cartwright declares that Canada has not progressed.

Free trade, as the liberals practice it, means a tax on tea, sugar and coffee and coal, which an intelligent protective policy admits into the country free of duty.

It is the home market that the English farmer is now pleading for, and it is the home market that the liberals ask Canadian farmers to throw away as worthless.

The conservative party is greater than any one man or any combination of men, because it is actuated by a living principle; good will to all and faith in Canada.

Nothing must be done to help the farmer, is the liberal cry. And it is evident that the farmer has taken the opposition at its word and determined that nothing must be done to help the liberals.

In free trade England all the tea imported pays a duty of four pence a pound. The same article comes into Canada under a protective duty tariff.

Our imports of tea in 1894 were 20,551,739 pounds, which had they paid duty at the English rate would have taxed the consumer \$1,644,139.

Under free trade the narcotics are taxed; under protection they are free.

The free trade policy does not commend itself to an independent commercial authority like the Montreal Trade Bulletin. It declares, "that the introduction of a policy based on the broad lines of British free trade would hurt us as a commercial people from which it would take us years to emerge."

Mr. Laurier is urging us on to the precipice, but he urges in vain.

Eighty-five members of the Imperial Parliament have banded themselves together for the purpose of securing some measure of protection to the industries of Great Britain.

If their success would mean an import duty against Canadian produce we could best afford to wish their failure.

But when Great Britain protects herself against ruinous competition it will be possible for her to give the colonies an advantage in her markets over foreign competitors.

So the British protectionists may be working in our interests as well as their own.

The Toronto Globe is again asking its liberal readers: "Has protection made you rich? If they were perfectly frank and honest they would reply that it has enormously increased their opportunities of obtaining employment in this country, and thereby enabled them to live comfortably and happily, whereas free trade would have brought the product of cheap labor into competition with their own, and have driven them out of their best market, the home market.

Protection has done more for the farmer, it has made it possible for them to make themselves rich.

The patrons in North Ontario attacked the government for subsidizing steamers to bring the produce of Australia into competition with the Canadian farmer. This is precisely what has not been. The steamers are subsidized to take Canadian produce to Australia and thus enlarge our market. Against the Canada there is a trade protection in Canada there is a trade protection. Abolish this tariff, as the patrons and liberals would do, and competition will strike a deadly blow at agriculture and every other industry.

If the patrons want us to isolate ourselves by living without communication with the outside world in order to prevent competition they are greater protectionists than any country has yet produced.

Liberal Mismanagement.

In the year 1879-8 the expenditure on the post office and public works departments amounted to \$2,584,051, while the revenue was only \$2,150,392.

This involved a net charge on the treasury of \$433,659. When the liberals had been in power for five years, applying their principles of economy to the public service, the expenditure in these two branches had risen to \$4,196,375.

Thus the revenue was \$2,242,373. Thus the charge imposed upon the treasury in respect of them was increased from \$433,659 to \$954,000—a rise of 180 per cent.

Another way of putting it is that it cost the people \$1.50 to collect every dollar of new revenue from two principal sources of income during the liberal regime.

Now, what took place after the return of the conservatives to power? Just this: In 1893-4 the expenditure for the two departments had risen to \$7,432,068, with the revenue at \$6,512,086.

The deficiency to be made up out of the general funds of the country last year was \$920,000, being \$84,000 less than it was sixteen years ago, when the liberals were in power. Every dollar of new expenditure under conservative rule has been taken care of by increased revenue without the addition of a cent to taxation.

In the interval the postal service has been extended through the Northwest, and the weight of three-cent letters has been increased from a half ounce to an ounce, the delivery system has been enlarged, canal tolls have been reduced and freight rates on government railways lowered.

Accounts of Merciless Massacres and Starving People in Turkey.

London, Dec. 14.—A despatch from the correspondent of the United Press in Constantinople, under the date of December 13, says:—Advices received here from Aleppo, under date of Nov. 30, say it has been proved that thirty Armenians have landed with arms and bombs at Endlich and started for Zeitoun.

The despatch says that this was done with the connivance of the authorities at Endlich.

The representative of the United Press in Constantinople, telegraphing under yesterday's date, says that advices from the interior showed that forced conversions from Christianity to Mohammedanism are occurring everywhere.

Women and children whose husbands and fathers have been killed and whose homes have been destroyed have, rather than lead a life of vagabondage, accepted Islamism, whereupon they were hounded and fed by the Turks.
