A Wire from Coast to Coast.

Montreal, April 28.—Work has been commenced on the new C.P.R. transcontinental copper telegraph line between Montreal and Vancouver. The line will pass via Vancouver and the Short line to Ottawa, and thence by the main line to the coast. It will be strung under the supervision of Mr. W. J. Camp, the C.P.R. electrician, in three divisions. The first one will reach from Montreal to Fort William, and will be constructed by Mr. Foxworth, with about 100 men working simultaneously in four gangs. The next division will reach from Fort William to Donald, B. C., and will be under Mr. S. S. Jenkins, superintendent telegraph, Winnipeg, with three gangs of men. Work on this section will commence in about a week and it will be necessary to rebuild some sections of the pole line between Winnipeg and Donald. The final division will reach from Donald to the coast, and will be under the charge of J. Wilson, superintendent of telegraphs who, with his two gangs of men, will commence operations in about three weeks. When completed there will be a line between 2,900 miles long, constituting probably the longest direct land line circuit for daily work in the world. To pass across the continent, telegraph signals will only occupy about one fifth of a second.

Potatoes Poisoning.

Within the last few days a number of persons in New York City have died from potato poisoning, so that public attention is now directed toward the mysterious nature of these poisons, which are not generally well understood. "Potomine" is a generic name for alkaloid bodies formed from animal and vegetable tissues during putrefaction and the similar bodies produced by pathogenic bacteria. It comes from Greek words meaning "to poison" and "to fall." Very often, perhaps generally, the degeneration in the food product is not far enough advanced to offend either the taste or the sense of smell; consequently, suspicion is not excited, and a person eats or drinks something which is developed to the point of making a great deal of trouble, if the result is not fatal. We often hear, in the summer, for instance, that persons who attended a picnic were stricken with a violent illness, and that the physicians in the neighborhood were kept busy for hours. The fact is developed that only those who ate potatoes were made sick. Sometimes it is reported that some one had poisoned the milk of a cow, but in such cases the poison is in the milk out of which the ice cream was made. It is not an easy task to trace the history of milk back far enough to reveal the precise conditions under which the atoms were developed, but it is believed that failure to properly cool the milk immediately after it was taken from the cow is a partial explanation of the evil. A hot weather favors this condition. The potatoes of ice cream (potomine) are particularly to be dreaded, as well as the other poisons, such as mycotoxins, found in mussels.

It is not pleasant to contemplate that the air we breathe, and the water we drink, and a large proportion of our food are full of bacteria of different kinds. Most of them are, fortunately, harmless, or should be if proper precautions are taken. Milk is far from being the only medium for the transmission of this poison to human beings. A great variety of solid foods of animal origin, such as meat, fish, and eggs, are frequently the cause of poisoning by canned goods, such as potted meats or canned salmon, for instance. In some cases the cause of the trouble, but in the majority of cases the sickness, especially if it is of an intestinal and painful character, is due to the use of these poisons. The food may be entirely fit for consumption, and perhaps none of those employed in the canning house may be responsible, but the chances are that unperceived putrefaction has set in and that potomine has been produced. In fact, these poisons are not exempt from the tendency to develop potomine. Indeed, fish was one of the first sources from which these poisons were obtained by chemists. The earliest feat of this kind was performed with gelatine in 1863. Since that time Brieger and others have found a variety of potomines, such as cadaverine, putrescine, peptotoxin, muscarin and tydotoxin.

Several cases which have occurred in New York City have resulted from eating shell fish, and though it is probable that the tragic death of the great musical conductor Anton Seidl was not caused by this cause, it is not unlikely that the fatal delirious delirium has been taken by many people, owing to the fear which they have of being poisoned by it. The symptoms of this disease are vomiting, nausea, diarrhoea and retarded respiration, and in advanced stages coma. There is no known antidote for this poisoning, but if the patient is given purgatives should be used where the poison is suspected. There are numerous potomines in the body, but they are absorbed by the oxygen or expelled by the bowels, liver and lungs. If not, they strike the nerve centers and sickness results. In a real cause of any mysterious death is potomine poisoning, but there are, of course, many cases of it which do not result seriously. Scientific American.

Our Means of Peace.

War Cannot be Avoided.

War between the United States and Spain can now be averted only by the immediate and complete surrender of Cuba to all her enemies. There is, however, no prospect of Spain humbling herself; on the contrary, extensive preparations are being made up on the Balaic and Canary Islands, and on the coast of Morocco. Crews have been sent out to take over two ironclad battleships from Hamburg, and the employees at the Government arsenals of Ferrol, Cadix and Cartagena are working night and day, turning out a bottom end of hulls for the new ironclads. The Spanish Government has been advised by the Spanish War Office to suspend hostilities against the insurgents, according to the circumstances in Cuba. The war is still being waged wherever the hands of hostile insurgents come upon the Spanish troops. In the interior of the island the insurgents are attacking the garrisons at Matanzas City; another encounter occurred at El Conde, where the insurgents lost nine men and the Spaniards five. The armistice is looked upon as merely a political move, and the Spanish press commends the Government's action in taking advantage of a truce to prepare for war. President McKinley's message is considered most important, and there is much talk of preserving the patrimony of the Spanish people. The report of the Foreign Affairs Committee, presented to the Senate by Mr. Davis, accused Spain of being guilty of the destruction of the battleship Maine, either by the official act of the Spanish authorities, or by the negligence equivalent to the criminal act. It states that "the duplicity, perfidy and cruelty of the Spanish character as they now have been exposed by the strained still to continue by their manifest, and in consequence, the committee justified intervention. General Lee has advised the Foreign Relations Committee against recognizing the present Government of Cuba. The Flying Squadron, under the command of Commodore Schley, sailed from Old Point yesterday for a 48-hour practice in firing at sea. The Navy Department has decided to buy the trans Atlantic liner St. Paul and St. Louis and the Canadian steamer Niagara.

Situation in China.

Berlin, April 17.—A prominent diplomat here says Russia, Germany and France have been exchanging notes for a long time on the situation in China, and Great Britain recently joined in the conference, as a friendly understanding will probably be reached before long in regard to both the present and the future. The same authority says both Austria and Italy desire to share in the great game in China, and Germany is supporting them. It is understood that other Governments have intimated that they will not oppose Austria and Italy securing convenient harbours in China.
