DAILY SUN PHOTOGRAPHS.

Valuable Records of Old Sol's Face Made at Greenwich.

The sun is photographed at Greenwich on every clear day, according to the last annual report of the Greenwich observatory...

Photographing the sun for this purpose has been a part of the routine work of this observatory for the last forty years. It was the first regular service to which photography was put by astronomers.

Work on the astrophotographic chart of the heavens has made good progress at this observatory during the year which ended April 30, 1893, when 1,629 out of the 4,454 hours during which the sun was above the horizon—that is, at Greenwich, and what is about the same thing at London, during the year the day sky was overcast by clouds about two-thirds of the time.

One of the New Processes. The driving of foreign substances into animal tissue by means of electric currents has been adopted, it is known, with great success in both medical and dental work.

The Growth of Towns. According to recent statistics concerning the populations of various countries from 1890 to 1892 it appears that during that period the population has been doubled at Amsterdam, Birmingham, Brussels, Manchester and Rome.

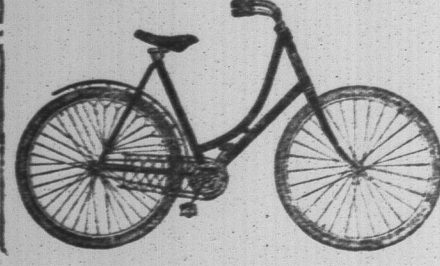
