The British Empire.

Belleville Daily Intelligencer, Dec. 16. The following address was delivered by Rev. Bro. Wm. Galbraith, LL.B., to the members of L.O.L. No. 274, Belleville, on the evening of Friday, Dec. 2nd, 1898:—

In England, for example, an accused person is considered innocent till he is proved to be guilty in Scotland there is an intermediate class, "not proven," where evidence is sufficient to excite suspicion, but not to establish guilt. The Parliament of the United Kingdom continually adds to the distinctions by passing acts confined in their operations to one or other of these component parts.
