Great volumes of smoke and showers of a hes and running lava came out of the object. After many days the disturbance subsided, and the natives could see that a new island had come to join the group and they called the new arrival Bogosloff. The island was about half a mile long, and was 350 feet high. The island in reality was nothing but the volcano, for from the water line it towered from all sides up to the summit. A peculiar feature of the mount was that it had no well-defined crater. From many fissures which cut across the sides of the mountain and around the top huge volumes of smoke came, but at the top there was no hole. Still notwithstanding this deformity, Bogosloff was very lively, and made more fuss than all the rest of the larger vol-




