The Sultan is hastening preparations for the effective fortification of the Bosphorus and the Dardanelles. He does not propose to intrust the work to Turkish officers, but has already engaged some of the best engineering talent in the German Army for the purpose. With the consent of King and I said I would do anything for him, William, Major Steffen of the German Army has been given a leave of absence, prolonged for three months, to instruct the Turkish artillery in the use both of heavy guns for fortifications and field pieces. The artillery is to be thoroughly reorganized under the Major's supervision, and the work of reorganization will keep pace with the laying out of the fortifications. New cannon are to be supplied from German and British foundries, and both the Bosphorus and the Dardanelles will be put in a condition to give a hot reception to any fleet endeavoring to force an entrance.

THE SULTAN AND THE ENGLISH.

It is said that the Sultan thoroughly agreed in his recent conference with Sir William "Yes," remarked Mr. Clark as the Times White, the British Ambassador, as to the growing danger of an attack upon Constantinople by the Russian fleet from the Black Sea, possibly aided by the French from the Mediterranean, and he then and there declared his purpose to put himself in a position for a defence that would last sufficiently long to enable friendly powers to come to the rescue. The Sultan is known to be deeply attached to Constantinople as the seat of the Ottoman Empire, and to have no intention of abandoning it.






