**ACCIDENT.**—On Monday forenoon Mr. George Metcalfe, who is employed on Brandon Bros.' farm in Verulam, met with a serious accident while drawing logs that had been sawn into the proper lengths to split into rails. A horse had been hitched to one end of a log that had been cut, but not quite through, and, instead of breaking off as was expected, the whole log slewed around, and, striking Mr. Metcalfe a little above his left foot, knocked him down, broke both bones of the leg and badly sprained the ankle joint. Notwithstanding the seriousness of the accident, he managed to hobble, with no

assistance but such as was afforded by a stick, a distance of nearly three quarters of a mile to the house, where he got into a buggy and drove to the Falls, where he was attended to by Dr. Graham, to whom he was about to pay a second visit when we saw him on Wednesday afternoon. He said that the setting of the broken bones, an operation that he underwent without taking chloroform, was exceedingly painful, but that afterwards he had suffered less from them than from the sprained ankle.
