Two Sailing Vessels From London to Sydney and San Francisco.

One of the most exciting and closest ocean races ever engaged in was that between the British ships Arctic Stream and Cromdale, now in San Francisco. They left the starting point within five minutes of each other and, after battleing against contrary winds for over 8,000 miles, there was only a difference of two hours between them at the finish.

Although a much smaller vessel the Arctic Stream held her own throughout, and on a tonnage allowance would have won hands down. Capt. Bowen is well satisfied with the showing made by his vessel and is of the opinion that if the race was run over it would be his vese sel that would be two hours ahead at the end of the voyage.

The Cromdale and Arctic Stream left London on August 1 last. Down the channel the vessels scudded along under lower topsails and reefed foresail. As they disappeared from view there was not a hundred yards between them, and the tugboat captains remarked to each other that it was going to be a close race. Both vessels were bound for Sydney, N.S.W., and Capt. Andrew and Capt. Bowen sighted each other three times during the race. On this occaseion the Cromdale won easily, as she made the run in seventy-four days, while the Arctic Stream took eighty days to cover the distance. This was not a test of the sailing qualities of the two ships, however, as light and baffling winds prevailed nearly all the way from Australia to San Francisco. THE KILLED AT ABBA CARIMA.

An estimate of the losses sustained by the Italian troops in the disastrous battle of Abba Carima, in Abyssinia, has been made. There took part in the engagement five Italian generals, of whom two were killed Da Bormida and Arimondi, one was taken prisoner, Abbertone, and two returned to headquarters, Baratieri and Ellena. Two of the seven colonels engaged were killed, one was captured and four 'retreated." Fifteen out of _ twentyfour commanders of battalions were killed. The total number of Italians who went into action was 9,500, of whom only 3,000 have returned, many of them wounded, while only 400 are prisoners. 
