FACTS ABOUT THE PLAGUE

INFORMATION ABOUT THE BUBONIC DISORDER.

San Francisco's Fight Against the Disease Among the Chinese.

Some interesting information on the bubonic plague, a case of which reached New York the other day, is given by Toronto's Medical Health Officer, Dr. Sheard. The information is all the more interesting because Canadians are able to look at this fearful scourge dispassionately.

The plague is a disease of the blood and lymph. The swelling of the lymphatic glands in the groin, commonly called buboes, gives it its name. It is prevalent in India, China and Japan, and is the result of

infected merchandise, as well as by infected persons and animals, seems clear. It was discovered in Honolulu, December, 1899, and the port was immediately closed. Six weeks later it appeared in the Island of Maui, although there had been no communication with Honolulu for ninety days. Investigation showed that the outbreak occurred shortly after the Chinese New Year, when a number of Chinese had assembled and a merchant had opened a package of candies and foodstuffs that had been in his store for two months before the outbreak in Honolulu. Nine cases of the plague occurred in Maui immediately after.

INDIA'S EXPERIENCE.

In Calcutta at the end of 1896, cases of fever with glandular swellings were reported to the municipal authorities, but although the plague bacillus was demonstrated in five out of eleven cases brought to the notice of the authorities the existence of the plague was denied by a commission appointed to examine the evidence. It is significant, however, that they ordered the strictest measures of isolation and disinfection. In 1898 its presence could no longer be denied and 192 deaths occurred. In 1899, two and a half years after its first appearance, the severest epidemic of all broke out.

In Meau, a Portuguese colony 30 miles from Hong Kong, six cases of plague appeared in May, 1894. These were all the cases observed until nine months later it re-appeared, and by May, 1895, the death rate was 30 per day.

San Francisco, which is America's great danger point in this respect, has troubles of its own in fighting the plague, although it has succeeded in keeping it down. The Chinese, among whom it appears, keep to themselves and do not readily admit the health authorities. To a certain extent the press and a section of the merchants of the city afford bitter opposition to the Health Board.

ELECTRIC FLY KILLER.

A new apparatus has been invented for killing flies by electricity. It looks somewhat like a gridiron, placed vertically, with a horizontal shelf hanging beneath. The "gridiron" is composed of wires which are connected with an electric battery, and the wires are so close together that a fly alighting can hardly fail to stand upon at least two of them at once. The wires being alternately negative and positive, the insect by the mere act of lighting upon the machine completes the circuit, and is instantly killed. At intervals the horizontal shelf may be removed, and the dead flies brushed off.
