FACING TYPHOID FEVER.

London Has Reached Limit of Growth With Safety.

What is bound to become one of the greatest problems of the twentieth century has suddenly confronted London, England, in a peculiar form. It consists of one of nature's warnings that the limit has been reached, beyond which it is impossible to crowd a greater population than is now comprised in the world's metropolis.

Dr. Collinridge, the chief medical officer of London, has issued a report in which he announces that all of the Thames fisheries, including the estuary, are contaminated with the bacilli of typhoid fever. His condemnation includes the famous Whitstable oyster beds, where 20 per cent. of the oysters examined were found to be infected. A ban has also been pronounced against whitebait, shrimps, smelts, and cockles.
