In that time his income was \$2,000,000 It took him fifteen minutes to walk from his private car to a room in the Hotel Green. For that walk he was repaid by an increase to his wealth of \$1-750. The first night of his stay he slept eight hours, and awoke \$54 759 richer for his repose. With the aid of his valet, it took him exactly half an hour to dress. By the time he was ready for his breakfast he could have signed a cheque, in favor of himself, so to speak, for \$3,500, that being the amount he earned in that brief space of time. The ourney from his bed chamber to his chair in the hotel dining-room occupied paid him \$570. After breakfast, three hours were spent on the golf links, for which enjoyment, thanks to the American people, he received \$20,534. After luncheon, as he slowly lighted his eigar, \$100 came into his possession.
