ELECTRIC BREAD-BAKING.
Electric baking-ovens have long been available, but their use has not spread very rapidly, probably because of the cost, or the difficulty of procuring the requisite current. In the little Swiss town of Kerns, where electric power is cheap, the electric baking-ovens has just been established in a satisfactory manner. In a furnace less than eight feet long 100 pounds of bread, in loaves of one and three pounds each, can be baked at one time, and eight bakings can be made in 12 hours. The cost of the heating is a little more than one cent and three-quarters per pound of bread.

THE BANK OF OTTAWA.
Has Had a Prosperous Year.

The thirty-fifth Annual Report of the Bank of Ottawa directors shows most substantial progress during the year ending November 30th, 1900. Though the earlier part of the year still showed the effects of the financial depression of 1898, conditions have changed materially during the last three or four months and prospects for 1900 are bright. The bank's net profits for the year were \$421,068. After paying dividends, writing off \$57,357 from the valuation of bank premises and furniture, and providing for the officers' pension fund, nearly \$50,000 was added to the balance brought forward from the previous year, making the balance carried forward to next year \$455,919.

During the year 5,000 shares of new stock were issued at a premium of 100 per cent., increasing the paid-up capital from \$3,000,000 to \$3,297,550. As the rest fund was increased by a similar amount the bank's capital and rest together now total \$6,595,100. The increase of \$4,000,000 in the bank's interest-bearing deposits during the year is a further indication of the growth of the institution's business with the general public.

The total assets during the year have also increased very materially—from \$33,524,891 to \$39,212,189. Altogether the Bank of Ottawa is to be congratulated on a very satisfactory year's business.

LACE-MAKING IN IRELAND.
Keeps Girls at Home.

In 1905 some of the people of Cootehill, county Cavan, Ireland, started a lace-making class with a view to providing pleasant and profitable employment for some of the girls of the district. A competent teacher was secured, and so successful has been the little industry that the amount realized by the sale of the work during the past four and a half years has amounted to \$17,325.

One hundred girls have been kept at home in profitable employment who would otherwise have emigrated to America. The demand for a good class of Irish hand-made lace is so great, it has been stated by more than one manager of a lace depot, that there are orders booked that cannot be executed in twelve months. The occupation of lace-making is clean, healthy and not laborious, and Irish girls have shown a remarkable adaptability in acquiring the beautiful art.
