

If it did not go to the rich, to whom would it go? You get only a small part of the wealth you produce. Do not the products of your hands and brains pile up the millions represented by the colossal fortunes of modern times? If they do not come from you, from whom do they come? Surely you must have brains enough to see, if you will but think, that when others make millions YOU LOSE WHAT THEY GAIN. You see, it is not like your work. Your work actually produces things; their work is only in MANIPULATING YOU AND YOUR PRODucrs, so that they gain without producing? Can't you see that you are being robbed, by a system based on profits, to the extent that others gain ? If you raise a crop, that crop is not profit, it is your PRODUCT. But the men who manipulate it and make millions out of it-that which they gain is profit. We know well enough, for science has proven it, that you could have from three to five times as much for your crop or your labor as you now get. Would you be injured by getting more for your own products It would not be right for you to make a profit off the products of others. That is why the present system is wrong. All the great fortunes, all the thousands of kingly palaces, all the great factories and shops and mines and machinery and office buildings and business blocks of the nation, are what have been taken from you and your fathers before you. The Sugar Trust.

To show you how private enterprise robs you, let's instance the sugar industry. The present trust took over sixteen little companies with a combined capital of \$6,590,000, and then began to water it. It took profits so enormous that it increased its propety to something like \$100,000,000, and paid in the meantime \$130,000,000 in dividends, and that during the last twenty years! In other words, it has taken from you 100 per cent. every year on the capital actually invested. Now this government borrows money at 2 per cent. interest. If the public owned and operated the sugar refining industry, you would have saved \$260,-000,000 on the one item of sugar alone during the last twenty years. But you vote to have sugar a private industry, and you get skinned to a frazzle. And above all this, the private owners of the industry have paid enormous salaries to their officers, to their lawyer, to their lobbyists and others. All this you have brought on yourselves, because you are too blind and stupid to realize the cause of it all—the private ownership principle. And what good comes to you by reason of the private ownership? You get none of the profits, none of the benefits; but you pay for them into the pockets of the rich and corrupting classes. Will you always remain stupid? You could have sugar to-day for two cents a pound if it were a public monopoly, and there would be some direct benefit to you, which you will never receive so long as you vote for men who do n't believe in publicly owned industries.—Ib.
