

CUT TREES WITH WIRE. It fell to the ground, and both master and pupil stooped at the same moment to pick it up, when to the horror of Leech there was a collision; the master's head struck that of his royal pupil.


"Well, Mr. Leech," the queen said, brightly, before he could find words for an apology, "if we bring our heads together in this way, ought to improve rapidly."
