

Human tree dwellers are not yet extinct. A Malayan newspaper describes an interesting discovery made in South Canara. The Kudiyas, living near Mangalore, include, it appears, a clan who have become tree dwellers by necessity. They live in huts built amid palm and other tall trees in order to protect themselves against attacks of elephants and other wild beasts of the jungle. Their clothing consists of the bark of certain kinds of jungle trees, and they subsist on yams and meat. They are darkskinned and noted for their fine physique, the women being even more muscular than the men, and one of their chief occupations is honey-gathering, a very dangerous employment, since the bees of Canara build their honey combs on the treetops often as much as 120 feet high.—Pall Mall Gazette.
