

AN OPEN-AIR BARBER

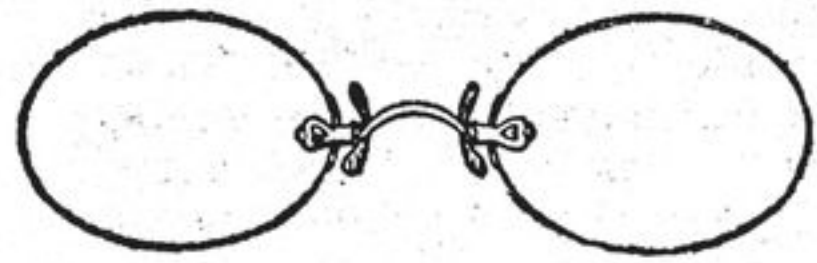
