### AFRICA'S GREAT FORESTS.

One of the great natural treasures of Africa is the immense extra-tropical forest that extends almost unbroken from the extreme southern end along the eastern highlands to the equator. There are gaps in it, and the trees change in kind somewhat with change of latitude, but upon the whole it has the same character throughout. The altitude above the sea changes regularly with degrees of latitude. Near the Cape the forest grows at sea level; in Natal and the Transvaal its altitude increases to 3,000, 4,000 and 5,000 feet; and on approaching the equator it rises to 7,000, and finally to 10,000 feet. In the equatorial highlands the growth is very vigorous, and the forest is enriched with the "penic cedar" of Abyssinia.

"A funny incident occurred on a German railway train whereon I was a passenger," says one who spends a bit of his time abroad. "A certain stolid Teuton had been assigned to a seat in the coach that obliged him to ride backward through the Black Forest. At the first stopping place he asked the postmaster, pursuant to German regulations, to give him another seat, saying it made him ill to ride backward. ### ROYALTY ON SHIPWRECKS.

#### A Spanish Prince and His Wife Cast Ashore on English Coast.

The Duchess of Fife and her daughters appear to be the only royalties of recent years to undergo the ordeal of shipwreck, with the possible exception of the Archduke John of Austria, who, according to one theory, lost his life at sea, says the London Chronicle. Prince Henry of Prussia, however, who circumnavigated the globe twice before he was 20, has on two occasions braved a watery grave. When he was a lieutenant his ship was caught in a violent squall and one of the sailors was washed overboard. Prince Henry plunged after him, and despite the heavy sea, succeeded in effecting a rescue. Some years later he rescued another sailor from drowning off the South American coast at a point where the sea is infested with sharks.

The Dorsetshire coast was once the scene of a royal shipwreck. In 1506 Prince Phillip of Castile and his wife Juana were sailing from Flanders to Spain when a violent storm cast them ashore near Poole. Philip was prevailed upon to accept the hospitality of a local magnate, Sir Thomas Trenchard. But Henry VII. invited the Prince to Windsor, adding that he would take no refusal. The Earl of Arundel, with a troop of 300 horse, escorted Philip to the royal residence, where he was entertained for about a fortnight. Henry took advantage of the enforced visit to extort some concessions from the Prince on matters at issue between them, and then sent him to Spain by way of Falmouth.

The alarm was given and the attack was beaten off. Out of gratitude the thistle was adopted as the insignia of Scotland.

### A BEGGAR'S AWFUL FATE.

Soon, however, they came upon a scene of horror. A couple of furious mastiffs, let loose earlier in the evening, had scented out and denuded the body of the woman, which they were then ferociously tearing to pieces. The unfortunate victim expired in the hospital the following day. She was 72 years of age.

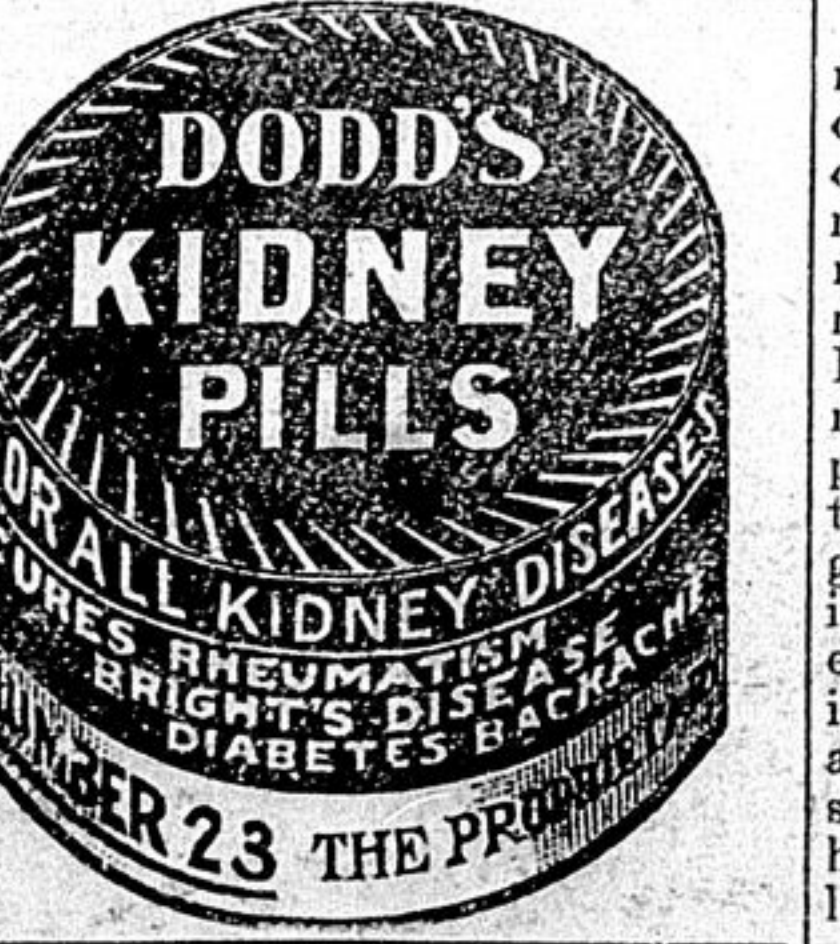

**NOT ALWAYS PURE.**  
Rain water is not always pure or nearly so, for under unusual conditions it brings down with it various small bodies present in the atmosphere. Thus there are "blood rain," due to the presence of vast numbers of the minute organism Haematococcus, and "sulphur rain," containing pollen grains of pines when these are set free about the end of May. During recent gales it was found that rain falling in the Midlands, England, consisted of strong brine, leaving a salt incrustation on windows and walls after evaporation. Apparently the sea spray had been carried by the high winds as far as 70 miles inland before coming down as rain.
