

NOT ALWAYS PURE.

Rain water is not always pure or nearly so, for under unusual conditions it brings down with it various small bodies present in the atmosphere. Thus there are "blood rain," aue to the presence of vast numbers of the minute organism Haematococcus, and "sulphur rain," containing pollen grains of pines when these are set free about the end of May. During recent gales it was found that rain falling in the Midlands, England, consisted of strong brine, leaving a salt incrudition on windows and walls after evaporation. Apparently the sea sgray had been carried by the high winds as far as 70 miles inland before coming down as rain.
