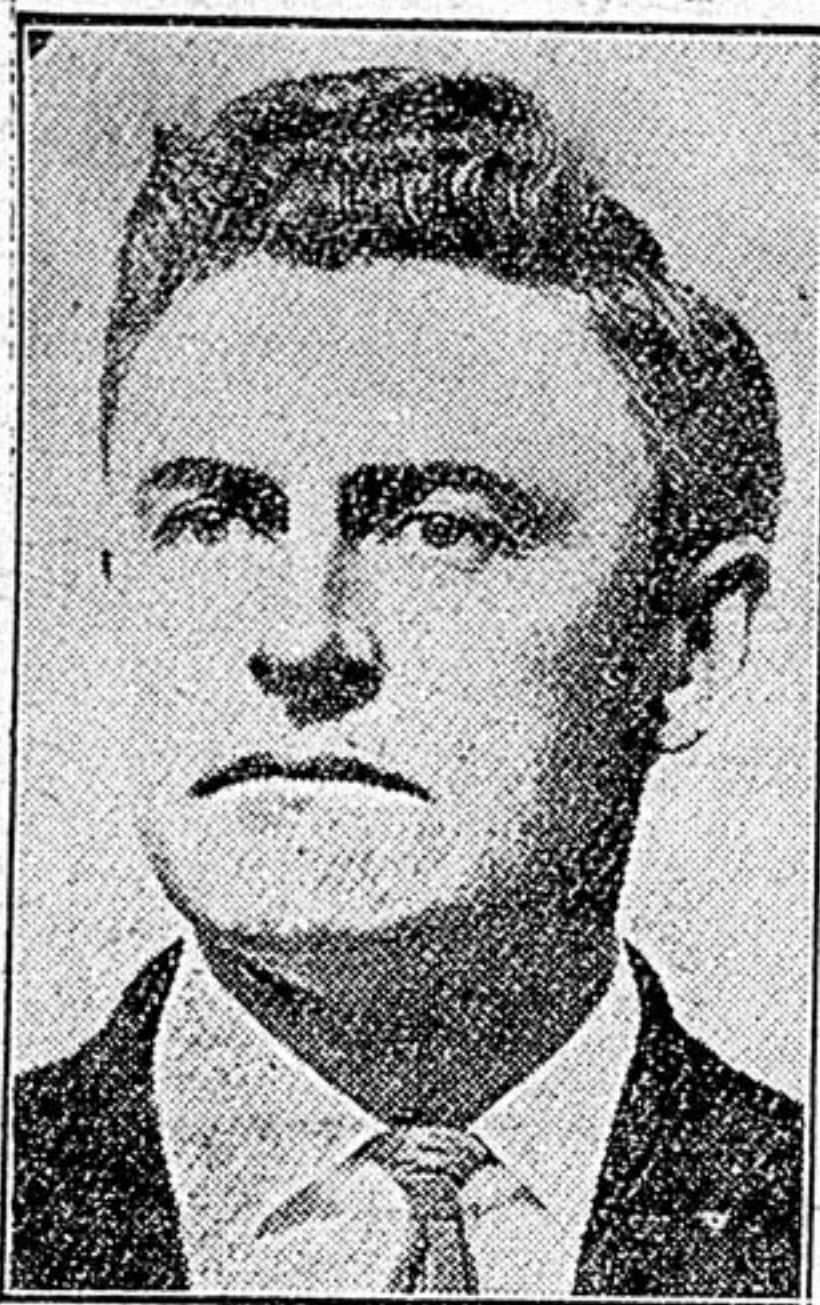

EXAMINE THOSE TO WED.

Swiss Society Makes a Unique
Suggestion.

A striking innovation in the direc-
tion of enforced medical examina-
tion of women has been suggested
by the Swiss Society of Public Util-
ity for Women. The proposition is
that young Swiss women should un-
dergo a medical examination on the
same system as their brothers when
entering the army; that the mea-
sure should be made compulsory,
and that a certificate of health and
fitness for motherhood should be
issued to each young woman who
passes the examination.

In a recent report of the society,
Swiss women were urged to undergo
examinations for the sake of them-
selves and their country. The ex-
tremists in the society wish the test
to be applied to both men and wo-
men, irrespective of army require-
ments, and made compulsory by law
under conditions that govern the
granting of life insurance policies.
They also seek a law making it com-
pulsory for clergymen to demand a
medical certificate from applicants
before marrying them.

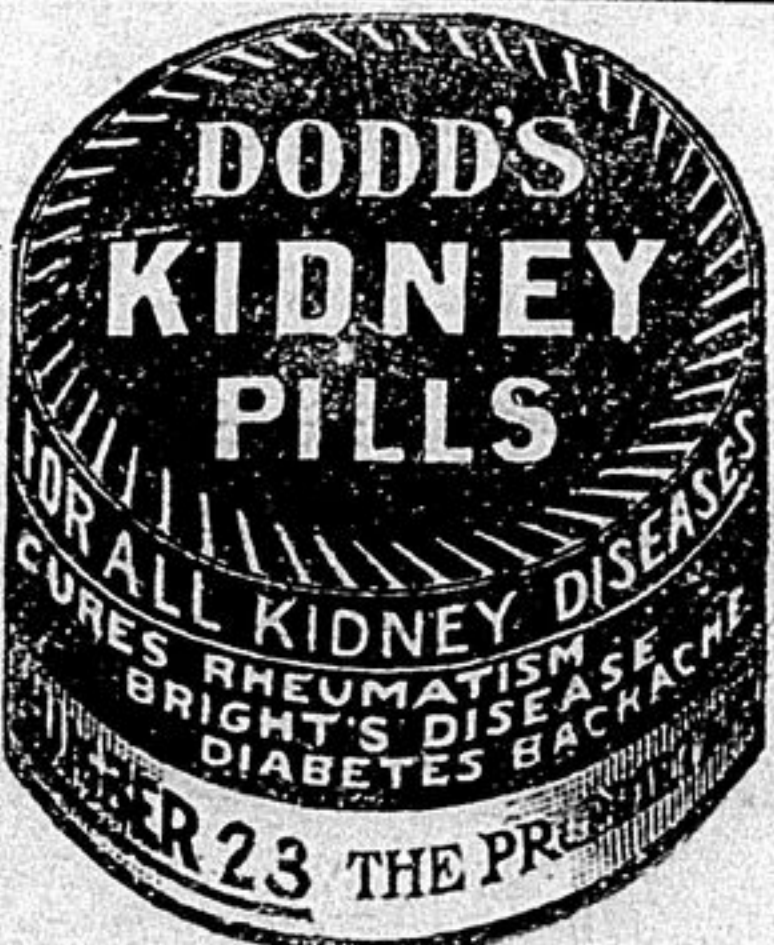

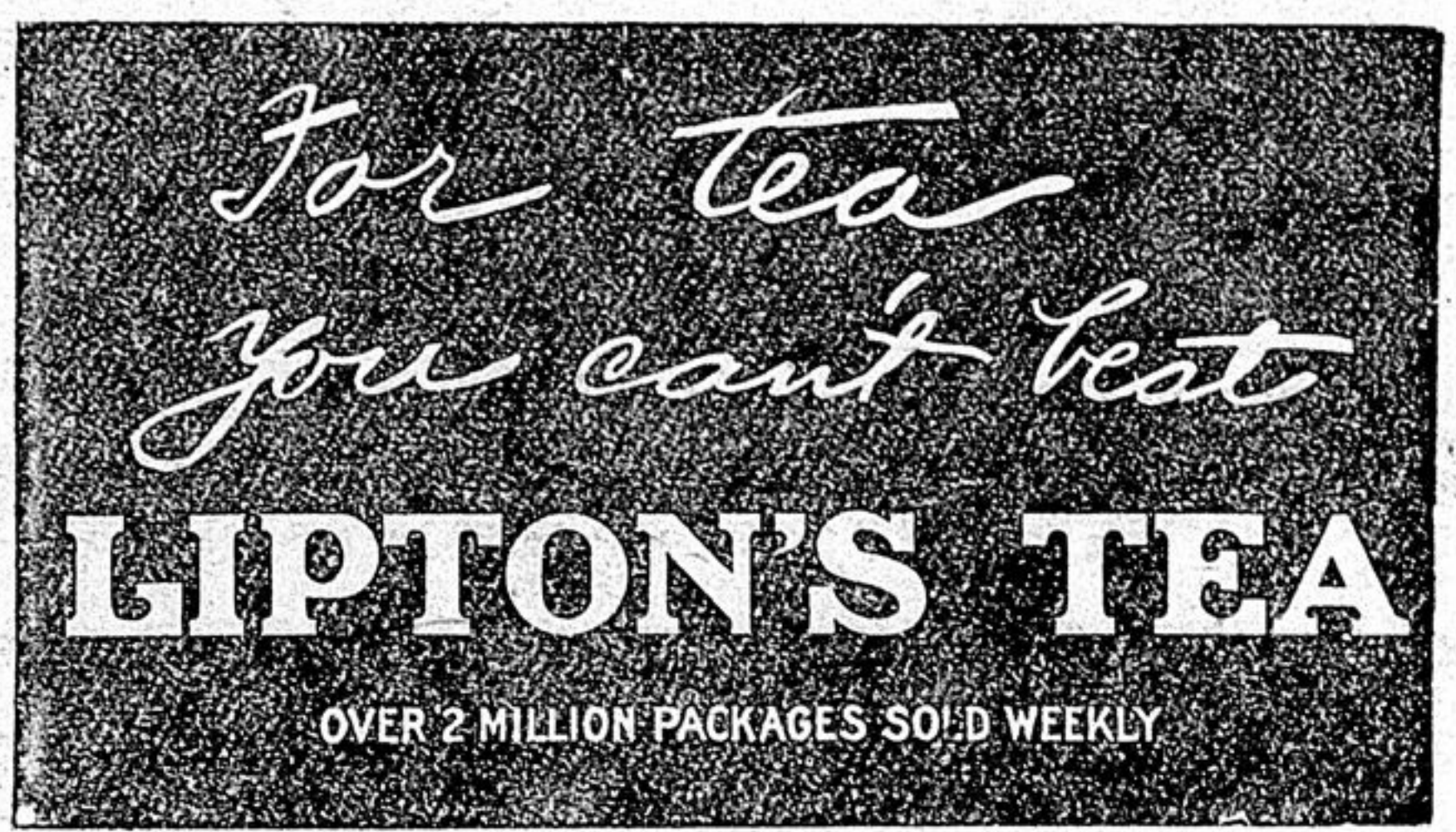
