

MOTOR STREET CARS.

Electric trolley-cars are to be replaced by "petrol tramcars" on the short line between Morecambe and Heysham, in the northwest of England. One car is already in successful use, and two other cars have been ordered for the line. Each car carries 37 passengers, and is driven by a 55 horse-power, fourcylinder gasoline motor. The cost of the running and maintenance of the "petrol tram-car" well be studied with interest by street railway managers. Many believe that the car will be a serious competitor of the trolley system, since it requires no heavy expenditures for overhead or underground equipment or for generating-stations.

THE OLDEST METAL.




