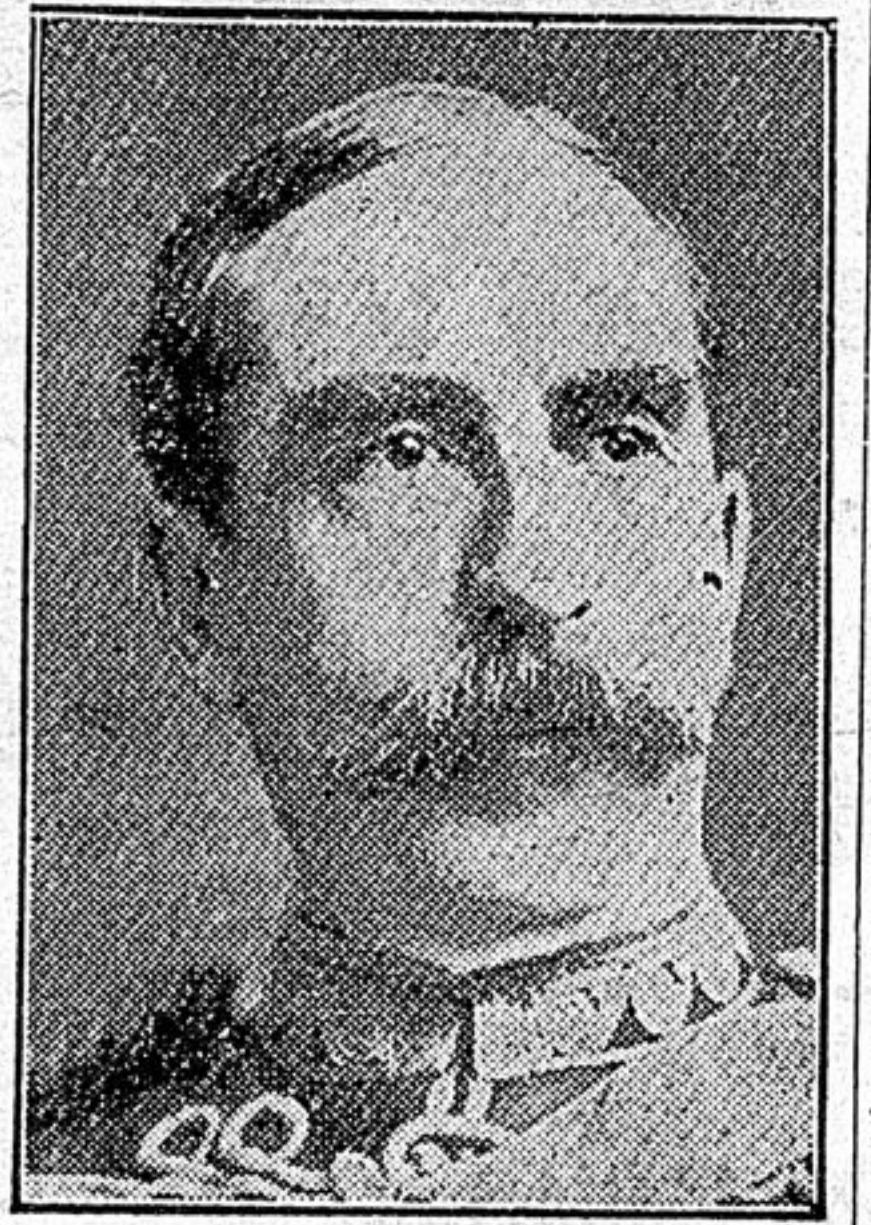

### MOTOR STREET CARS.

Electric trolley-cars are to be replaced by "petrol tramcars" on the short line between Morecambe and Heysham, in the northwest of England. One car is already in successful use, and two other cars have been ordered for the line. Each car carries 37 passengers, and is driven by a 55 horse-power, four-cylinder gasoline motor. The cost of the running and maintenance of the "petrol tram-car" will be studied with interest by street railway managers. Many believe that the car will be a serious competitor of the trolley system, since it requires no heavy expenditures for overhead or underground equipment or for generating-stations.

### THE OLDEST METAL.

A recent paper presented to the Royal Institution at London in discussing the question of the metals used by the great nations of antiquity pointed out that gold was probably the first metal known to man because it is generally found native. The oldest metallic objects to which we can assign a probable date are thought to be those found in a royal tomb at Nagada in Egypt supposed to have been that of King Menes. In one of the chambers were some bits of gold and a bead, a button and a fine wire of nearly pure copper. If the tomb has been properly identified these objects are at least 6,300 years old. Nearly all the ancient gold that has been examined contains silver enough to give it a light color. It was gathered by the ancients in the bed of the Pactolus and other streams of Asia Minor.

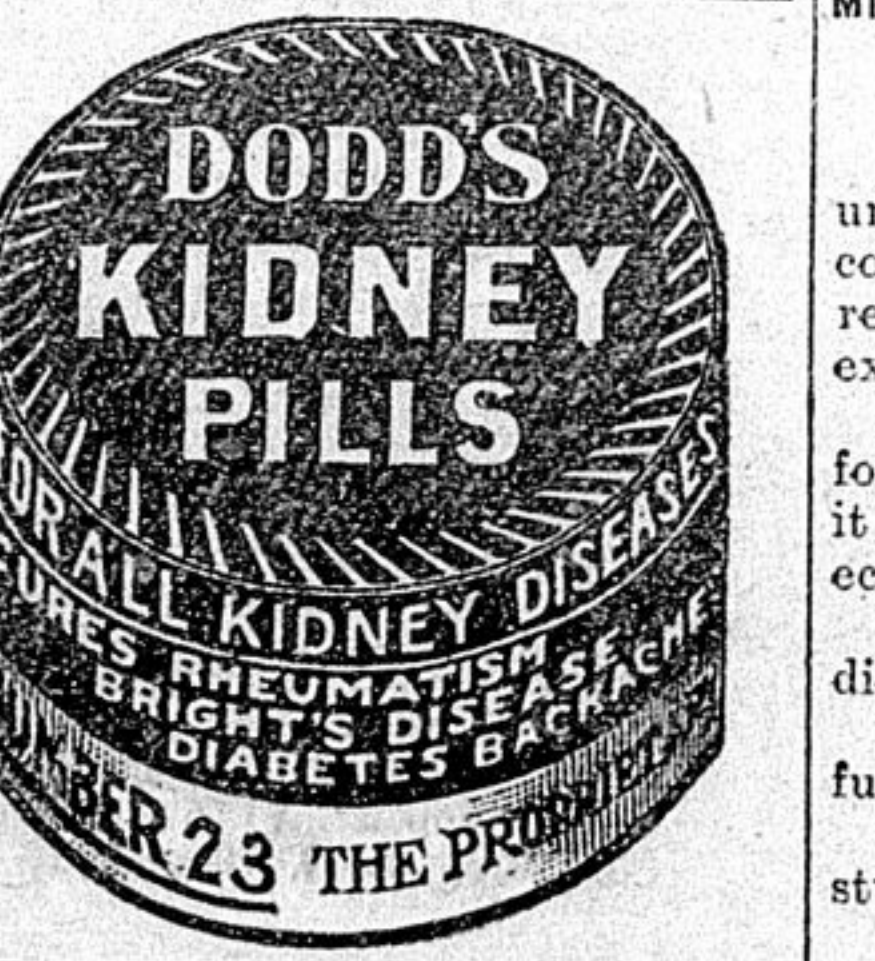
