

## EAT AND SLEEP IN AUTO

U. H. Dandurand's Tipless Pullman With Berths and Kitchen.

Mr. U. H. Dandurand, always a specialist in automobiles, who had the first automobile in Montreal, and who has been running cars ever since, is planning to purchase a car which will have everything else on the American Continent lashed to the mast. Mr. Dandurand's new car is not so much a car as a country residence on wheels. It is a sort of tip-less Pullman. It will contain four sleeping bunks, which may be pulled down and made up in regular fashion, a smoking-room and a kitchen. It will be the best car of its kind on the American continent, and it will cost Mr. Dandurand \$15,000. The new car will carry a man servant as well as a chauffeur. It is understood that the good old custom of leaving your boots out to be cleaned and finding somebody else's in their place in the morning, the step-ladder for upper births, and the clothes massage at the end of the trip will be strictly adhered to. For long tours over the country, Mr. Dandurand thinks his new car will be the best ever.

## BRITAIN AND HER COAL

Supply Sufficient for Four Hundred to Six Hundred Years.

Based on statistics compiled in 1903, and on an increase annually of 2½ per cent., the coal consumption of Great Britain is as follows:

Factories	66,000,000
Iron and Steel Works	35,000,000

Output of coal in British mines increases 2½ per cent. per annum.

## BAKING PAN LIFTER

Wire Frame Slides Through the Grooves on Side of the Pan.

An ingenious little cooking utensil that will save the cook a burned finger or two has been designed by a Massachusetts man. It consists of a baking pan with a lifting attachment by which it can be carried about without touching the hot pan, even under the protection of a cloth. The opposite sides of the pan are turned down to form grooves. A piece of strong wire is bent into a handle and the two ends form long prongs that can be thrust through the grooves on the sides of the pan. The prongs are bent slightly downward at the points so

they will not slip out too easily, but will afford a purchase on the grooves when the pan is to be drawn out of the oven. Even with a cloth for protection it is sometimes difficult to get hold of the pan when the bread or cake has risen to the edge.

## A HUGE STURGEON

An Enormous Fish on Exhibition at Vancouver.

A monster measuring 10 feet, 2 inches in length is on exhibition in Vancouver. This huge specimen of a sturgeon was caught by two fishermen in the Fraser off Steveston. They were fishing for spring salmon with a net and the monster became entangled in the net. It was taken after a terrific struggle, in which their boat was damaged, an oar being broken, and it was necessary to repeatedly gaff the struggling fish and finally use an axe before the men were able to put it out of business and disentangle their net, which was ruined in the struggle. This sturgeon is one of the largest that has been caught in recent years, although sturgeons weighing 200 to 300 pounds are often secured.

## CANADIAN SPEED LIMITS

Rates at Which Automobiles May be Driven

In Ontario the speed limit is 15 miles in rural districts, 10 miles in cities, towns and villages. The regulations in Quebec fix the country limit at 15 miles, towns and municipalities governed by Municipal Code, 9 miles, and 4 miles for sharp curves, bridges, steep descents, crossings and intersections. The regulations for New Brunswick and Nova Scotia are pretty much alike and practically the same as the Quebec laws. No tourist in Canada should overlook the regulation requiring front and rear lights. These vary in different provinces but if the car carries two white lights in front and one red in the rear, the tourists will satisfy all the requirements in this direction anywhere and everywhere.

## IRRIGATION IN ALBERTA

The Canadian Pacific Railway big irrigation dam at Bassano, Alberta is the biggest structure of its kind, now under construction in Canada. It is being built on the Bow River at a point locally known as Horse Shoe Bend, about three miles south west of Bassano, which is 83 miles East of Calgary. The dam is a composite structure, consisting of a long and high earthen embankment on the south bank of the river and a reinforced concrete spillway in the existing river channel. When completed the earthen embankment will have a total length of over 7,000 feet, it will have a maximum height of 45 feet and will be 350 feet wide at the base at its highest point. It will contain one million cubic yards of material.
