Mrs. W. Tipling, of Honey Grove, spent last week with her son, Mr. Will Tipling, of Cobocook.

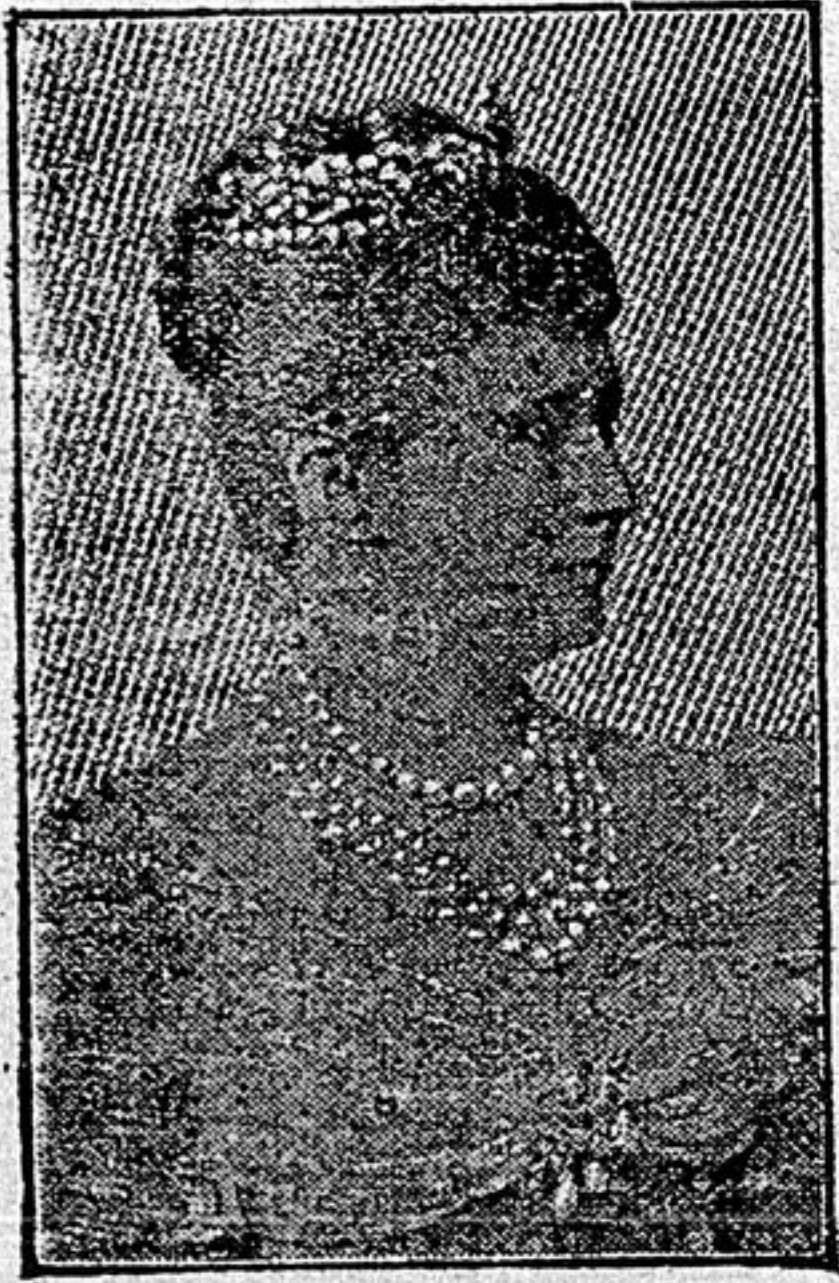
Miss Sara Moise, who has been holidaying at her aunt's, Mrs. Wm. Mitchell, for a few days, has returned to her home at Newcastle.

Owing to the unfavorable condition of the weather, only a few from around here took in the excursion to Haliburton on Wednesday last.

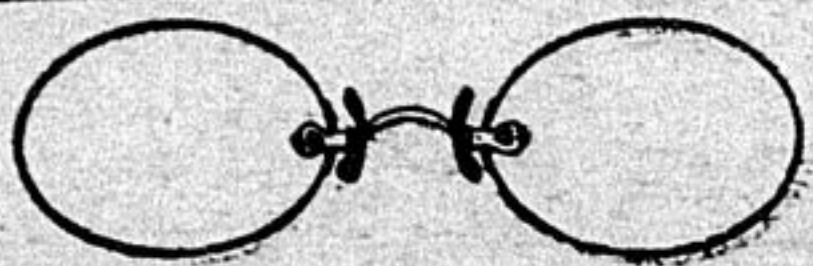


THE EMPRESS OF GERMANY

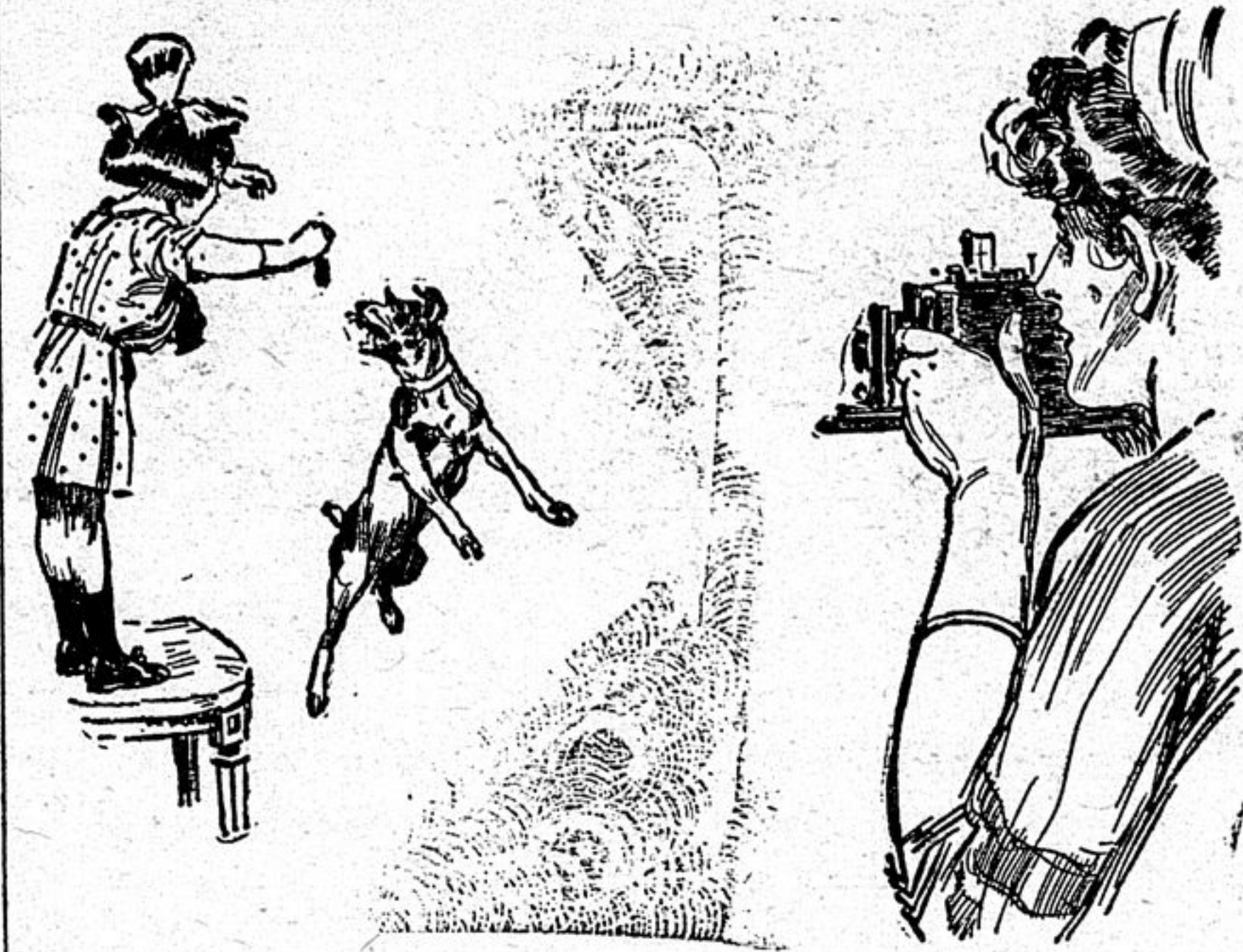
