The New York Graphite Co. are establishing a big graphite plant at Mumford, in Haliburton county. The plant will be the largest in the province.

Spraying with Bordeaux mixture will prevent rot in potatoes. The first spraying of the plants should be done about July 15th, and every ten days thereafter until Sept. 1st.

Iceland has no goals, no penitentiary; there is no court and only one policeman. Not a drop of alcoholic liquor is made on the island. Its 78,000 people are total abstainers, since they will not permit any liquor to be imported. There is not an illiterate person on the island, nor a child ten years old unable to read; the system of public schools is practically perfect. Much of the improvement is due to the abolition of the liquor traffic and prohibition of all alcoholic beverages in this compact little island of the north.
