BY-LAW NO.

A By-Law to prohibit the sale by retail of spirituous, fermented or other manufactured liquors in the Municipality of the Village of Fenelon Falls.

The Municipal Council of the Village of Fenelon Falls, hereby enacts as fol-

1 .- That the sale by retail of spiritnous, fermented or other manufactured liquors is and shall be prohibited in every tavern, inn or other house or place of public entertainment in the said municipality, and the sale thereof, except by wholesale, is and shall be prohibited in every shop or place other than a house of public entertainment in the said manicipality.

2.-That the vote of the electors of the said Village of Fenelon Falls will be taken on this By-law by the deputyreturning officers hereinafter named on Monday, the Sixth day of January, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen, commencing at nine o'clock in the morning and continuing until five o'clock in the afternoon at the undermentioned

Polling Sub-division No. 1, at Twomey's Hall; Deputy Returning Officer. Edward Fitzgerald; Poll Clerk, Walter

Polling Sub-division No. 2, at Jordan's Hall; Deputy Returning Officer, Charles W. Burgoyna; Poll Clerk, Alvin J. Gould. 3.-That on the Second day of January

A.D. 1913, at the Council Chamber at the Village of Fenelon Falls, at the hour of three o'clock in the afternoon, the Reeve shall appoint in writing, signed by himself, two persons to attend at the final summing up of the votes by the Clerk, and one person to attend at each polling place on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of promoting the passing of this By-law, and a like number on bohalf of the persons interested in and desirous of opposing the passing of this

By-law. 4. -That the Clerk of the said Municipal Council of the Village of Fenelon Falls shall attend at the Council Chamber in the Village of Fenelon Falls, at the hour of ten o'clock in the forenoon on the Seventh day of January A.D. 1913, to sum up the number of votes given for and against this By-law.

5.-This By-law shall come into force and take effect as from the first day of May next after the final passing thereof. Read a first and second time this Ninth day of December, A.D. 1912.
