But when the income was reinvested abroad the old law did not touch it. Now Lloyd George says all income of British subjects resident in the United Kingdom must contribute to the Imperial revenue. These foreign investments are estimated at more than a billion and a half dollars and from this the Chancellor hopes to secure \$1,250,000 this year, and double that amount next year. The total increase of revenue from income tax and death duties this year will amount to something like \$44,000,-


