A Timber Limit Breeze.

WHAT a howl of indignation would have been raised by the supporters of the Mowat government, had the White-Johnston timber limit deal been connected with the Ottawa civil service departments, instead of under the Mowat-Hardy regime at Toronto. In 1872 a timber berth on the north shore of Lake Huron was sold by the Ontario government at \$85 per square mile, one-half the purchase money being paid down.
