DRAINAGE BY-LAW

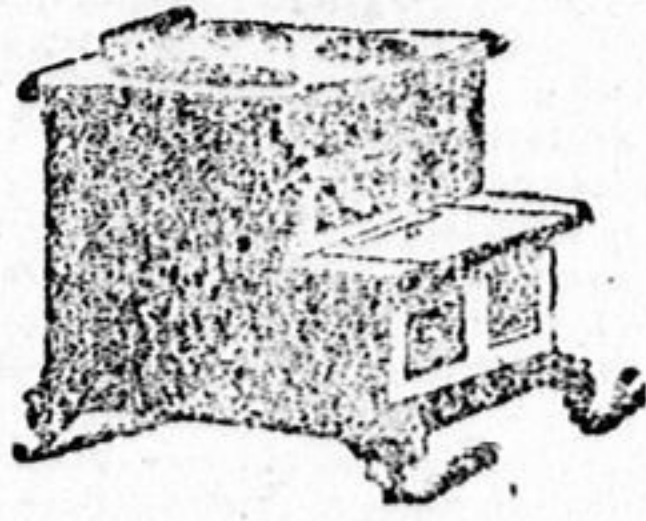

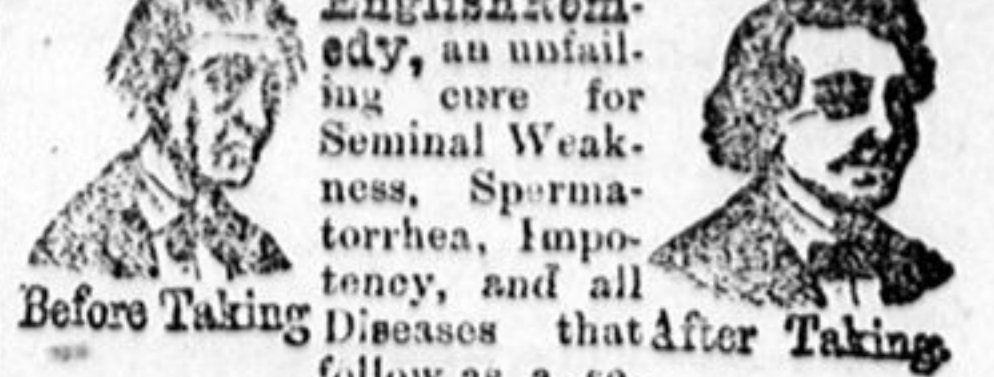
