

**ELDON TOWNSHIP COUNCIL.**

First meeting of the Eldon Council held at Woodville on Monday, the 16th day of January, 1882.

Members present, Eachern D. McEachern, Reeve; Robert Armstrong, Deputy-Reeve; Peter R. McEachern, Donald A. McIntyre; Wm. McKee, Councilors, who after taking and subscribing to the necessary declaration and qualification of office before Andrew Morison, Clerk of Eldon, took their seats at the Council Board and proceeded to the transaction of council business.

The Reeve appointed M. O'Neil, of Kirkfield, Auditor of Township accounts for 1881.

Moved by Wm. McKee, seconded by Robt. Armstrong, that David Siley, Woodville, be appointed Auditor of Township accounts for 1881, and that a By-law be introduced and read a first time confirming the same. By-law read.

Moved by D. A. McIntyre, seconded by P. R. McEachern, that By-law No. 21, for the purpose of appointing Auditors for Township accounts for 1881, be read a second and third time and passed, and that the Reeve and Clerk do sign the same and attach the Seal thereto. Carried.

Moved by D. A. McIntyre, seconded by Wm. McKee, that Arch. H. Campbell be Assessor for the Township of Eldon for the year 1882, at a salary of \$75.00, and that a By-law be introduced and read a first time confirming the same. By-law read.

Moved by P. R. McEachern, seconded by Wm. McKee, that By-law No. 22, for the purpose of appointing an Assessor for the Township of Eldon, for 1882, be now read a second and third time and passed, and that the Reeve and Clerk do sign the same. Carried.

Moved by P. R. McEachern, seconded by Robt. Armstrong, that the Treasurer be authorized to pay the interest on Railway Debentures held by W. Rei, of Toronto by him furnishing a bond with proper security to the Township of Eldon approved by our Council at his expense indemnifying them from loss. Carried.

Moved by Robt. Armstrong, seconded by Wm. McKee, that the time for returning the Collector's roll for 1881 be extended until the 15th day of February, 1882. Carried.

Moved by P. R. McEachern, seconded by Robt. Armstrong, that the Reeve grant his order to the Treasurer for the sum of eight dollars in favor of the pithmaster in Woodville for sidewalks, on condition that Marietta do grant a like sum for that purpose. Carried.

Moved by Wm. McKee, seconded by P. R. McEachern, that Thomas Metcalf be allowed the amount of his taxes as part payment on his contract on 3rd Quarter Line, Con. 1, Eldon. Carried.

Moved by D. A. McIntyre, seconded by Wm. McKee, that the Reeve grant his order to the Treasurer for the following amounts: Jos. J. Cave for printing, \$18.50; N. Ore & Co., Toronto, election blanks, \$8.73; Henry Thomas, repairing scraper, \$1.00; Moses Kelso for culvert of town line, \$14.50; Duncan T. McFarlane, Deputy Returning Officer, Ward 2, \$7.00; Robert Campbell, Deputy Returning Officer, Ward 3, \$7.00; Wm. Conolly, Deputy Returning Officer, Ward 4, \$7.00; and that each pay for the use of the hall for holding said elections. Andrew Morison for Ward No. 1, \$3.00; delivering ballot boxes, \$3.00; Police Commissioners, Woodville, for hall, \$2.00. Carried.

Moved by P. R. McEachern, seconded by Wm. McKee, that this Council do now adjourn to meet again at Hartley, on Monday, 13th March next, for dispatch of business. Carried.

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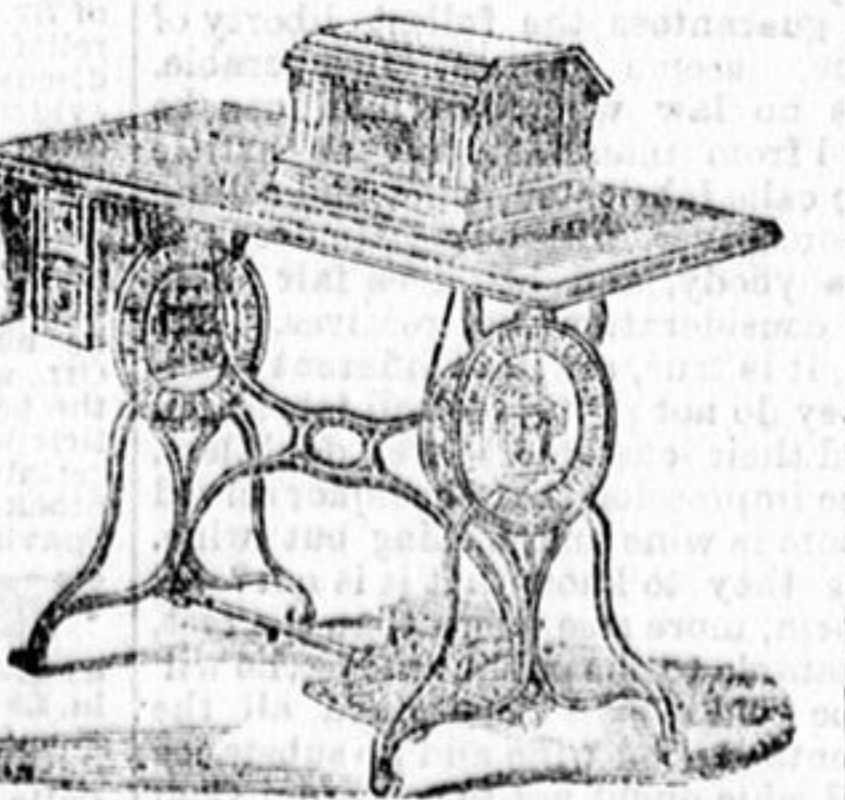
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
