Ure & Co., Toronto, election blanks. \$3.53; Henry Thomas, repairing scraper, \$1.00; Moses Kelso for culvert of town line, \$14.50; Dancan T. McFarlane, Deputy Returning Officer, Ward 2, \$7.00; Robert Campbell, Deputy Returning Officer, Ward 3, \$7.00; Wm. Conolly, Deputy Returning Officer, Ward 4 \$7.00; and that each pay for the use of the hall for holding said elections. 
