A CORRESPONDENT of the Chicago Medical Times recommends Mr. Gezon's formula as a care for corns, which is as follows :- E Sal icylic acid, 30 parts, or grs. xxx; extract cannabis indica, 2 parts, or grs v; tollodion, 540 parts, or f. 8 ss. The Times tays :-The collection fixes the acid on the diseased part, and gives speedy relief by protecting it from friction. The cannibas indica acts as an anodyne, and the acid reduces and loosens the corn so that it comes off in four or five days, adhearing to the collection. The remedy is applied with a camel's hair pencil, and if the corn is not well cured the application may be repeated. In four or tire days the patient should use a warm foot-bath and rub off the collection. If any portion of the corn remains the said should beapplied again, and the treatment continued antil the whole of the corn has disappeaced. The skin will be soft and smooth, as in the healthy state,


