

MARIPOSA TOWNSHIP COUNCIL.
 Council met this 20th day of February, 1882. Members all present. Minutes of last meeting read and approved. The Clerk read a circular from S. H. McKittrick, Orangeville, referring to road scrapers, also a letter from D. Annis calling attention to the state of repair of the road between Lots 3 and 4, 15th Concession. Moved by Mr. Adam, seconded by Mr. Lowsbrough, that the Clerk be requested to draft a By-law imposing a tax of one dollar on dogs, and two dollars on liches in this township for the year 1882.—Carried. Moved by Mr. Broad, seconded by Mr. Lowsbrough, that the Reeve give his orders on the Treasurer in favor of the following delinquent persons: John Edwards, \$3.00; Mary Harden in care of T. Broad, \$3.00; Z. Jewell, \$5.00; Blew's family in care of A. Cameron, \$5.00.—Carried. Moved by Mr. Bowes, seconded by Mr. Lowsbrough, that the Reeve give his order on the Treasurer in favor of the following persons: J. L. Whitehead, amount due for lowering mill dam, \$121.12; Edwin Rogers, for building bridge 13th Con., \$100; Edwin Rogers, for work done on 13th Con. line, \$2.50; Joseph Maunders, account for stone lampposts, \$1.85; James Chidley, work on 8th Con. line, \$73.15; J. Kelly and G. Douglas, services as Auctioneers, \$8.00 each; C. D. Barr, account for printing, \$8.00.—Carried. Moved by Mr. Broad, seconded by Mr. Lowsbrough, that the Reeve give his order on the Treasurer in favor of John Bruce for the sum of \$1.50 for travelling two Movers by Mr. Bowes, seconded by Mr. Broad, that B. Adam be and is hereby appointed Commissioner to have the bridge repaired between Lots 3 and 4 in the 15th Con. of Mariposa.—Carried. Moved by Mr. Bowes, seconded by Mr. Parkinson, that the Clerk be and is hereby instructed to ask for tenders for printing for the year 1882.—Carried. Moved by Mr. Lowsbrough, seconded by Mr. Broad, that By-law No. 280 being a By-law to provide for levying a tax on eggs in the Township of Mariposa be now read a first time.—Carried. By-law No. 280 after passing through committee was read a third time and finally passed. Moved by Mr. Lowsbrough seconded by Mr. Bowes, that whereas a certain number of ratepayers in the village of Oakwood having petitioned this council to have steps taken to have the said village drained in compliance with the Ontario Drainage Act, this council instruct the Clerk to employ W. E. Warnold, Esq., P. L. S., to make the necessary survey to ascertain the probable cost.—Carried. Moved by Mr. Broad, seconded by Mr. Broad, that this council adjourn to meet again on the third Monday in March next to appoint pathmasters, &c.—Carried.


