Tun last, and what is claimed will be the best Social of the season, is to be held in the Town Hall, next Friday evening. We have been favored with copies of the Greenock Advertiser, (Scotland) in which our late townsman, Mr. D. B. McNabb, figures somewhat conspictive ously as a lecturer on "Canada." We were not aware that Mr. McNabb had the slightest aspiration in the direction of oratory and we must confess considerable surprise. The address is certainly a good one and lone that will impress many with the advantages of a residence in this peaceful country.

IT has been definitely settled that the trains on the T. & N. R. R. run into and from Union Station, Toronto, on and after 1st of April. Trains leave Toronto at about 7.45 a.m., and 4.35 p. m. Arriving in Toronto at 10.30 a.m., and about 9.30 p. m. They will run into the Union Station instead of Berkley St, as at present thus bringing business men much nearer the commercial centre of the city.

A CORRESPONDENT of the Orillia Times writing from Winnipeg, discourses as follows :- "I have inquired into the rumours which have appeared in Toronto papers that there are a thousand carpenters and others out of employ here. There is no such number out of employ, and it could not happen. In the first place they could not live here out of employment for they have to pay \$6 per week for board in common boarding houses, and board in the liotels is as high as \$4 per day. Furnished rooms without board are as high as \$2.50 per day. A single room with only a bed and two or three chairs, a very common carpet and a small heater rents for that price. A house of six or seven rooms brings from \$40 to \$50 a month rent, and cannot be got at that figure. It is folly for any one to come here with a family, unless able to build a house, and the price of building material is very high, three times as high as in Toronto. Carpenters' wages here last summer were from \$2 to \$2.50. This lasted until August and then a raise of 50 cents a day took place, and now the wages are from \$2.50 to \$3 per day of ten hours work. Firewood is \$6.50 a tamarac wood at that. People coming here in the spring will have to live in tents until they build for themselves. Everything is imported here readymade, principally from Montreal. The prices of provisions are as follows: Meat, from 15 to 20 cents per lb.; a 4 1b. lenf of bread costs a dollar; potatoes, \$1 to 1.50 per bushel; sugar, 7 to 8 lbs. for a dollar, eggs, 40 cents per - dozen; milk, 15 cents a quart; butter, 35 cents a lb."-Those of our readers Tall who meditate removing to the Prairie Province should carefully digest these




