THE petition against Mr. J. D. McIntyre of South Victoria was dismissed with costs.

LONDON, Ont. has been made the scene of another terrible disaster. This time a flood has spread destruction and misery among its people. Many lives have been lost and the loss to property will reach an enormous amount.

They have been only in operation for sixteen months, yet a profit of \$1,000 a month has been reached. The capital was furnished by benevolent men; but plate-glass windows, hard-wood finish, decorated walls, and tasteful furnishings, remove the impression of cheap charity. Not only are good meals furnished at a low rate, but there jare reading rooms, smoking parlors, and billard rooms, the idea being to furnish all the social attractions of the saloons, with the exception of intoxicating drinks.




