

WHEN a newspaper reporter discovers that a detective is endeavouring to ferret out any offender against the laws, he generally refrains from all reference to the matter which might tend to defeat the ends of justice. The death sentence passed upon Chester Munro at the late Assize Court in Simcoe county, for the murder of Thomas Cook, has been commuted to imprisonment in the Kingston Penitentiary for a term of seven years.

The capture of Cabul by Sir Frederick Roberts is fully confirmed. He visited the citadel on Saturday, and made a public entry into the city Sunday. The Afghan troops have been completely routed, and the tribes assembling to fight have returned home. The Ameer is now detained as a prisoner, and the fact that his intimate personal friends were leaders in the revolt may be accepted as pretty conclusive evidence that his own friendly professions have been feigned throughout.

The latest accounts from the White River Agency reveal a tale of horrible butchery. Every employee at the Agency appears to have been killed, and the women and children are missing. It is conjectured that they have either been carried off as hostages or butchered.
