SAD DEATH.—The Onemee Herald says:—"The announcement of the death of Miss Ellen Crawford will be received with regret by many of our readers, though suffering for some time from that dread complaint, consumption, she who saw her out driving on Wednesday thought her end was so near. Yesterday morning she intended taking a drive and had just arisen from her breakfast to prepare for going out, when she burst a blood vessel, and before many minutes was a corpse in her mother's arms. The deceased was much esteemed for her amiable qualities and her removal will leave a blank to be felt."

FENELON FALLS has had a small fire—sufficient to show the necessity of proper protection. The Gazette gives the following account of it:—"On Monday morning last, about half past 9 o'clock, the elevator which conveys the refuse from Mr. R. C. Smith's new mill to the bank on the south bank of the river caught fire in consequence of the spout catching up, and two heaps of slabs near the kiln were soon in flames. At a time the mill itself was in no little danger, as the wind was blowing directly towards it. A large number of mill hands and other villagers were quickly upon the spot; the engines were set out as soon as possible; scores of barrels were brought from the stores; and, after about half an hour's hard work, a fire was got under, though pumping had to be continued for some time longer before it was entirely extinguished. The damage is estimated at about fifty dollars, several rods of the elevator having been utterly consumed or so injured that its removal will be necessary. The little engines, which cost a mere trifle, have again proved of incalculable value, as, but for them, the mill—to say nothing of other property—might have been destroyed, as the force pump there was out of order and could not be made to work."

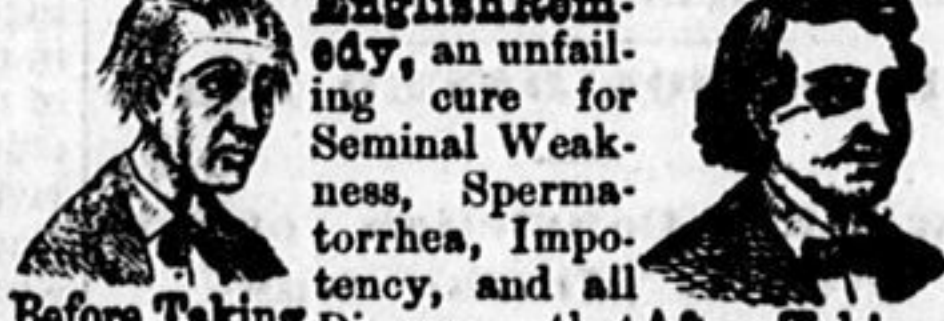
