the Six Nations, to be erected as marques ford, is making headway but slowly, as the public have not entered into the project with the enthusiasm anticipated by its promoters. Some liberal donations were received from members of the Government and others last year, Prince Arthur contributing \$100, and it was proposed to solicit contributions in England, but the idea was not carried out. It is just as well that it was not, for if there is not sufficient interest and public spirit to raise the funds for such an object in Canada, it is decidedly humiliating to make such an appeal abroad, The Board of Directors has recently been reorganized on a new basis, and it is stated that a handsome monument of Brant can be erected for \$15,090, leaving vacancies for the statues or busts of other chiefs to be filled subsequently. A renewed appeal is made for subscriptions in aid of the project.

THE Globe of Wednesday published full aud satisfactory reports of the state of the crops, principally in Ontario, and in its comments says that the country may be heartily congratulated on the crop prospects. Spring wheat is one exception to the general excellence of the crops, the weather having been somewhat unfavorable to that cereal.
