MOSES OATES, the weather prophet, (his predictions this year have proved much more accurate than Vennor's)

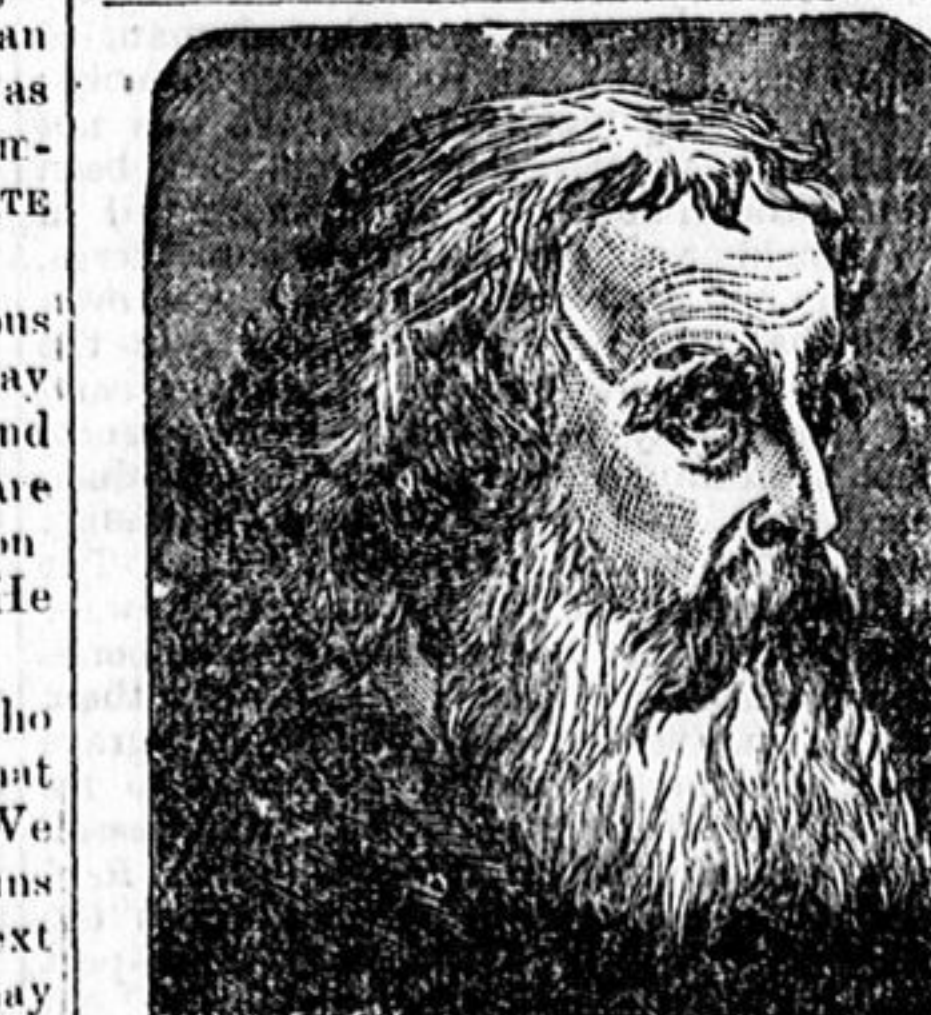

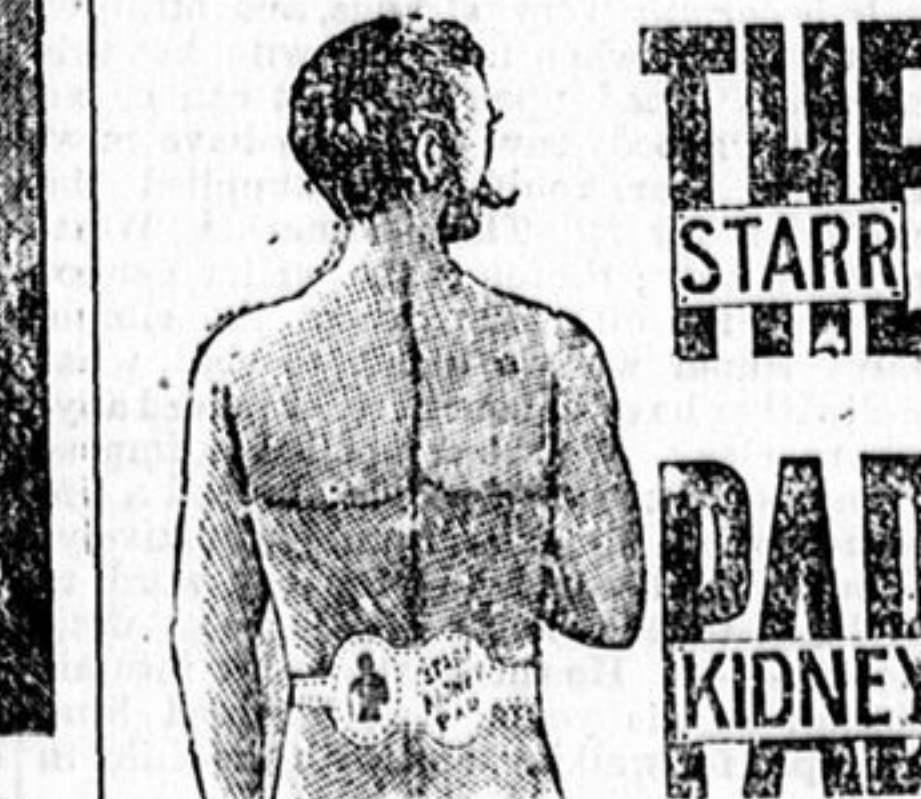
