BEET SUGAR EXCURSION BERLIN

Ontario & Victoria Counties Under auspices Whitley Board of Trade Wednesday, Feb. 4th, '02. Postponement to this date is due to bad roads preventing delivery of beets by farmers and consequent closing down of factory until week of excursion. To give those interested in the establishment of the beet sugar industry in this part of the province an opportunity to see a factory in full operation.
