"All we want is frost," declared Mr. Simpson to a Warder representative last night. The frost came during the night and everybody should be satisfied. The Toronto track was in poor condition, owing to the warm weather, but Lindsay's half-mile track will be in superb shape.

The Port Perry Trotting Association have their races scheduled for Thursday and Friday of this week. A rumor ground, town yesterday said that the ice was thin on Lake Scugog and the races might have to be postponed.
