An Englishman by the name of Mr. Herman Barker, writes the following letter to the Express, of Holmfirth, Eng. The writer advises fellow-Englishmen to keep away from Canada unless they have money, and refers to a visit made to Lindsay. It is as follows:

LIFE IN CANADA (To the Editor of The Express.) Sir,—I desire to draw the attention of your readers to the reports re the prosperity of Canada. Canada is a good place for keep out of, and I want the workers in the Holmfirth district to take warning in my experience. I have travelled in every part of this country for the express purpose of studying the conditions of the people, and the possibilities here to working men. The result of my observation is that Canada is a good place for a man with a little money, say £100, but for the average worker, it is worse than England.

When I return to the old country it is my intention to place before the people of your locality the truth. I am no agent of the C.P.R. or any other organization, and therefore have no object in view but that of presenting my friends from being misled and fooled.

Hymn Playing

(By H. C. Hamilton)

Perhaps an organist is judged by his hymn playing more than by his solo playing. To be a good hymn accompanist is of prime importance. A far-sighted organist will memorize both words and hymns of the most frequently used hymns. When this is the case he will be able to give full attention to the needs of the choir and those of the congregation, particularly in regard to support, and the matter of keeping all together. If the singing drags, the organist must try the plan of detaching the chords so as to give the effect of accent. This, in conjunction with very strict time, usually brings all together again.

Another very troublesome thing to organists is the singers' habit of singing flat. This usually happens in the morning more than at night. It is well to be prepared to play all the familiar hymn tunes in any key. With in the interval, of say, a third above and a third below their written key. In the morning, should the congregation attempt a hymn that goes into high F, it would be better to play it a tone lower, thereby making it easier to sing. If, however, the singing drops during the hymn, the organist sometimes can, by playing full organ, bring all back to the key; but if the flattening is persistent, he had better start the next verse one-half a tone lower. When singing at night the voice is usually a trifle higher than in the morning, and if the bass or alto parts are at all low it would be better to play from a semitone to a full tone above, in regard to interpretation, much can be made of many of the best hymns. Some books have expression marks (p, pp, mp, f, ff) at the different verses. But when these are absent the organist can, by thoughtfully digesting the meaning of the hymns, infuse a vast amount of feeling into the various lines. To play every verse alike is not only poor musical taste, but also denotes little sympathy with what the words mean.
