Instructive Addresses On Dairy Matters

Meeting Under Auspices of Eastern Ontario Association Addressed by Messrs. Publow, Hume and Others on Important Topics

A meeting under the auspices of the Eastern Ontario Dairymen's Association and the Victoria and Hamilton Cheese and Butter Makers' Association was held in the Council Chamber, Lindsay, on Wednesday afternoon of last week at which profitable addresses were given by Messrs. G. G. Publow, chief dairy instructor for Eastern Ontario, Alex. Hume, of Peterborough and others.

THE DAIRY 'COW' Mr. Alex. Hume, of Mennie, spoke on 'The Dairy Cow'. Some, he said, think the poorer in flesh the dairy cow is kept the better.

Mr. Thomas Robertson, of Dundas, President of that Board, was chosen chairman, and Mr. M. J. Lewis, of Lindsay, secretary of the dairy meeting.

Mr. George A. Gillespie, of Peterborough, buyer for Hodgson Bros., Montreal, said, in speaking of the cheese of the Lindsay section, he thought that it would compare favorably with any other.

Mr. Cameron, instructor in this district, made a few remarks. He touched upon the importance of developing the dairy herd, and keeping the milk supply in a better sanitary condition.

Mr. Wm. Thurston, of Bobcaygeon, Secretary East Victoria Farmers' Institute, here apologized for the absence of Mr. H. Glendinning, of Manilla, the representative of this district on the directorate of the Eastern Ontario Dairymen's Association.

Mr. Wm. Newman, of Lorneville, President of the Cheese and Butter Makers' Association, urged giving more attention to the dairy herd. The managers of creameries in this district were putting forth very strong efforts to turn out the best quality of butter they had ever done.

Mr. H. C. Hamill, Islay, gave his experience with feeding calves with skim milk. The first thing was to get acquainted with the calf.
