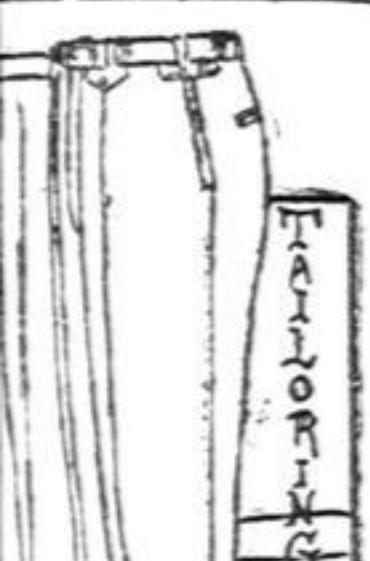

For Ten Young Ladies of Lindsay and Victoria County

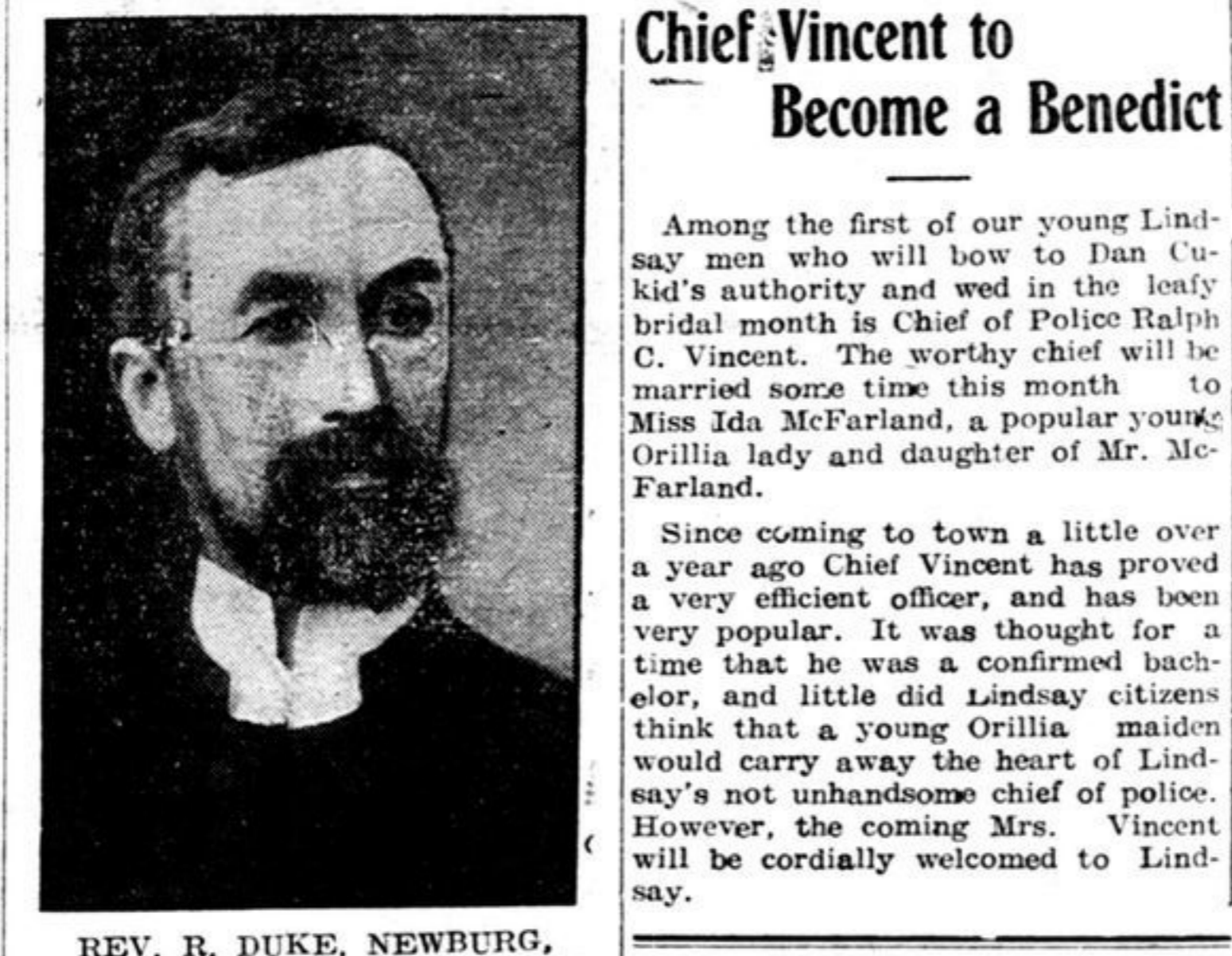

Jack Dougan Met With Accident

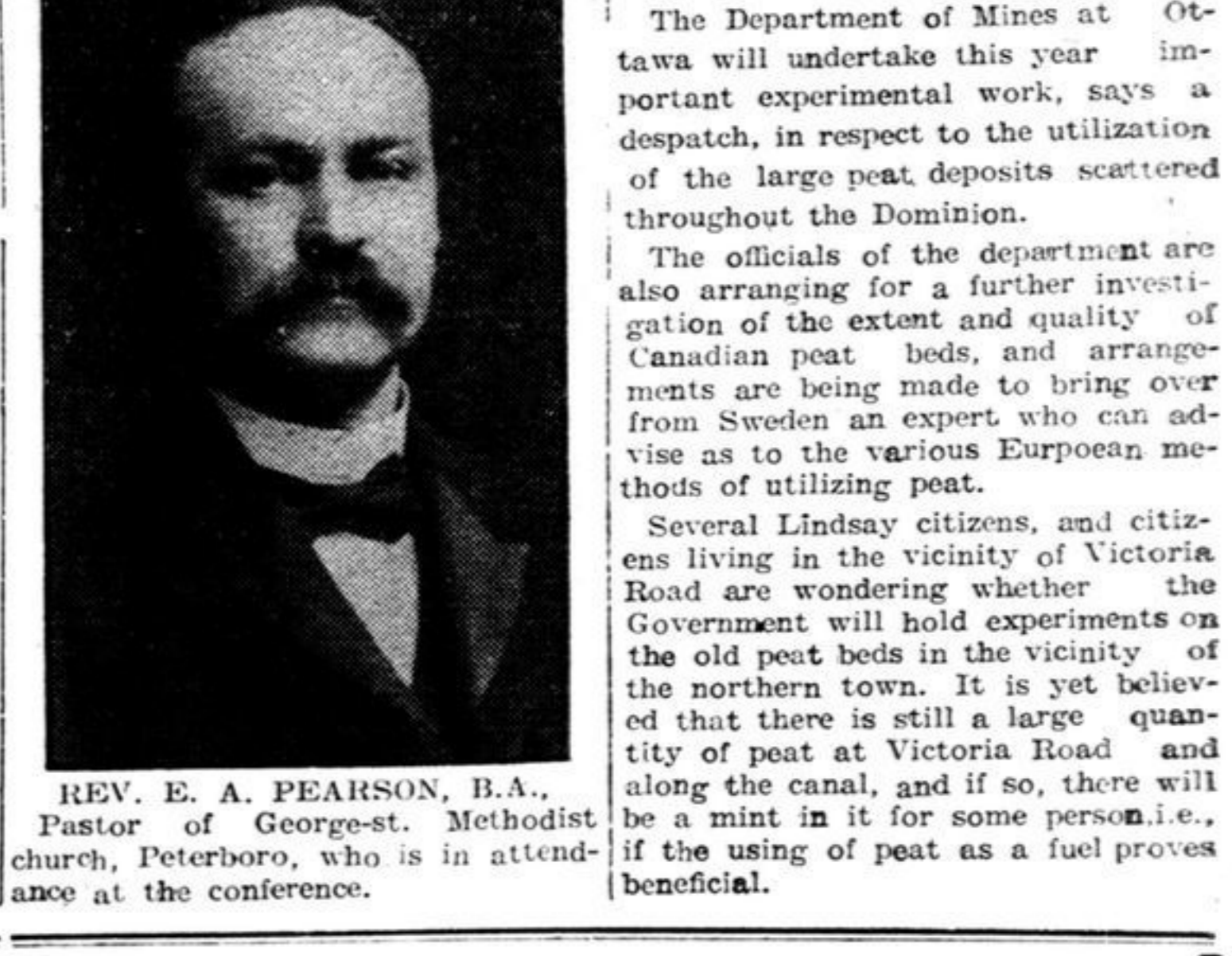
Mr. John Dougan met with a painful, though not serious accident, this morning. Mr. Dougan has been working for the past few weeks in Sylvester's binder department.
