cation Bill. Mr. Balfour in introducing the bill said the nation preferred denominationalism, as shown by three million scholars in sectarian schools, as against 2,600,000 in board schools. But as the law has stood for 32 years, no other school could enter where an Anglican school was giving sufficient accomodation. In 80,000 parishes in England and Wales there is no school but the Anglican, and the vicar or rector is master of the denominational school and pupils.
