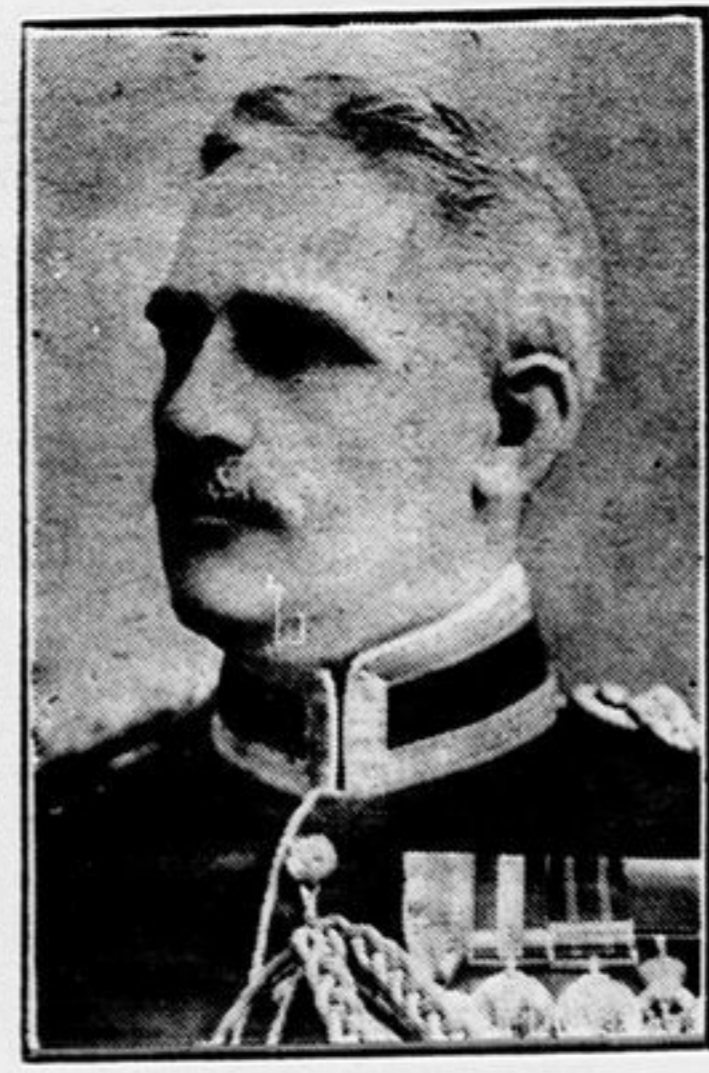

### COLONEL SAM HUGHES, M. P., THE MAN



Loyalty to party and interest in its success was manifested in no uncertain manner Saturday last when delegates from all parts of the riding gathered in the Academy of Music for the purpose of attending the Liberal-Conservative convention which was held for the purpose of nominating a candidate for the coming election, and Col. Sam. Hughes, M.P., was again chosen as the standard bearer for the Conservative party. The convention was largely attended by staunch Conservative delegates and was harmonious in every respect.

That Col. Sam. Hughes, M.P., would receive the nomination as candidate was conceded, he having served the riding and the party well as an able representative for a number of years. The convention was unanimous in re-electing him candidate as the association recognized the fact that he is to-day the strongest man the party has available, and has gained not only the loyalty and esteem of his political friends, but to a very large extent the respect and admiration of his opponents. Col. Hughes is a thorough Canadian and can be found at all times upholding the cause of Canada. In the House his voice is ever heard in the midst of the storm and he is known to be fearless and outspoken, a member who has weight in the House with friends and opponents.

Col. Hughes has little fear of the results of the election, nor have his followers, although it is never wise to be too confident, and the party will stick to him to a man; it is confidently expected that his majority this year will be greatly increased. Col. Hughes is stronger than ever before and has more friends in the riding, including a very large number of old-time Liberals. His Liberal friends and supporters will be increased this year owing to the free trade issue, which has nettled the farmers of Victoria and Haliburton. He will also receive the support of

by the introduction of the pact into the domain of practical politics is not merely an economic one—it is national and imperial.

The question is FOR KING OR EMPIRE, OR TAFT AND THE UNITED STATES.

A man's conscience comes into his politics as well as into his social and business relations. All party opinion no matter how great, its variety, is rooted in patriotism and it is generally conceded by some of the staunchest Liberals in the Liberal party that free trade with the United States should be the last resort. In fact there are scores of Liberals who have indicated that they will vote against their party at this election because they do not want to see United States make its roads on Canada, but rather want Canada to be independent and prosperous. Canadians, irrespective of party, would fight for their country if it were assailed. What they are called upon now to do for their country is not to resort to arms in its behalf, but to go to the polls as one man and put a stop to the foreign scheming and the domestic treachery for subordinating their country to the United States.

For these reasons, and for others which will be presented during the campaign, the voters of Victoria and Haliburton should mark their Canadianism and their Britishism by a solid vote for Col. Sam Hughes, add but it is likely that reciprocity will overshadow the grafts, the blunders, the general decrepitude of government that should receive great consideration.

But even the questions of internal moment pale beside the national issue presented for decision to Canadians. The economic aspect of reciprocity has been dwelt on since the announcement of the pact on January 26 and has demonstrated to those following the argument and citation of facts, that the cry of large markets is a delusion and a snare, the question involved in reciprocity; the crux of the situation produced

The Liberal-Conservative Convention of Victoria and Haliburton last Saturday in Lindsay proved an overflow gathering, when the party stalwarts met to nominate a candidate and Col. Sam Hughes, M.P., was nominated as the standard bearer. His nomination was unanimous and harmonious. His name was received with cheers, prolonged and repeated, from a convention that filled the Academy of Music. Col. Hughes' name was the only one considered and he was given an ovation that left no doubt as to his popularity.

The convention was presided over by President J. H. Delamere, of Minden, and with him on the platform were a number of prominent members of the party as well as Mr. E. Guss Porter, K.C., of Belleville, and in calling the convention to order at the morning session the President stated that he was glad to see so many delegates present. It was customary to elect the officers of the Association in the morning and proceed with the nomination and speeches in the afternoon, but when the President asked for the election of officers it was declared that the old officers had filled their positions well and by a unanimous vote they were declared re-elected as follows:

#### PRESIDENT DELAMERE

In thanking the convention for his re-election as president, Mr. Delamere stated that although perhaps the season was not convenient for the holding of a convention nevertheless he was pleased to see such a large gathering as it showed that the party was standing together and determined to win. The Conservative party was forced to go into the election because of the action of the Laurier Government in forcing the same upon the country. The speaker referred briefly to the Reciprocity question claiming that the Laurier administration was forcing the issue despite the fact that it would be disastrous to the country if the pact was passed. A few of the party went to Washington and pushed the loyal opposition at Ottawa stood firm and forced the Liberals to take the question to the people. Reciprocity would be a curse to the country and especially to the farmers. If the pact was passed it meant annexation and nothing less. Canada is in the eye of the world to-day—regarded as one of the most prosperous countries in the world, but Canada should be entirely independent of her neighbors to the south. Canada wanted to manufacture her own goods and not let the foreigners come in and undersell the Canadian farmer or form trusts. The speaker had the feeling that the good sense of the people of Canada would lead them to vote against reciprocity and annexation, and while Canada was in a prosperous condition Canada did not want to sell herself to any foreign country, and the reciprocity pact should be given a decided setback. In closing President Delamere stated that the riding of Victoria and Haliburton had been well and ably represented by Col. Sam Hughes. (Cheers.)

The mentioning of Col. Hughes' name as the standard bearer for the party in the coming elections was the signal for a spontaneous outburst of enthusiasm, the nomination being declared unanimous by three cheers for Col. Hughes. His nomination was moved by Mr. William Hetherington, of Verulam, and seconded by Mr. Wm. Brandon, of Fenelon Falls, Tohals McFadyen, of Eldon, and P. R. Switzer, of Gooderham.

#### COL. HUGHES

Col. Sam Hughes, M.P., the candidate was the first speaker called on and he was greeted with enthusiastic cheers. He expressed his appreciation at being once more nominated to represent this constituency, explaining that he had represented the electors at twenty-one sessions of parliament and had not yet found a Conservative who had left the party on account of any action of his. The Colonel explained that he had been approached by many prominent Liberals in the riding who had expressed the hope that he would run again at this election not for personal reasons but on account of the reciprocity or free trade question. He explained that he intended aiding Dr. Vrooman in his campaign and hoped to see him elected with a good majority and stated that already a number of good Liberals had been induced to support him and he was

of the opinion that many would leave their party on the issue for which the election was called.

this rifle he had defended it and would do so again, as his faith in it had been verified. With it the Canadian team had won the Bisley Contest for three years and it was with that rifle that the worlds championship had been won and he stated that it was his belief that within a few years the Ross rifle would be adopted all over the empire as the British rifle. The candidate explained that under ordinary circumstances there would have been no need for an election but the Laurier government was trying to cover up its corruptions. He explained the unequal redistribution of the different constituencies showing how his own riding extends over several hundred miles from one corner to the other. He stated that the Premier had seen a chance of covering up the misdeeds of the Government and at the same time thinking that he had an opportunity of bringing Canada under the United States rule, forced the reciprocity question and a general election. The Colonel explained the reciprocity issue in 1894 which was made during the civil war in the States when Canada did a great deal for the north and in 1875 when Canada would have been greatly benefited by the agreement they had swept away the treaty knowing that the States was the only outlet for Canada's surplus for six months in the year and thinking to force the Dominion into annexation. But at that time Confederation was sprung but the United States still refused to give Canada the benefit of her markets so that the great National Policy was passed and then followed the closer union of the colonies with Britain. This was Canada's answer to the demand for annexation at that time and the United States seeing that they could not get annexation by direct means is trying indirect. Messrs. Fielding and Patterson were sent down to Washington to do the wooing for Canada's hand. But looked up as they were by Laurier, and Taft, it yet rested with the people to say whether Canada was to be given to the United States. The speaker explained that the Liberals were trying to show that they were following the same lines as Sir John Macdonald, but he explained the difference, showing how that politician had proposed reciprocity in certain products with the States. The products which the United States wanted and did not produce and which Canada produced were exchanged for articles which the Canadians needed, and did not produce. This was entirely different from the present agreement, stated the Colonel, in which everything was to be exchanged, lumber for lumber, eggs for eggs, etc. But continued the speaker, the people must be consulted and he was sure that they would not allow the Yankees to gain control. Laurier and his government had held office too long, and were forgetting that the people were the masters.

G.T.P. EXTRAVAGANCE  
 In 1908 the government had sprung an expenditure of millions on the railway for the Grand Trunk Pacific and the colonel stated that the people should have had a voice in the matter. He also referred to the manner in which the Laurier government had taken from Alberta and Saskatchewan the right of regulating

#### A CURSE TO CANADA.

The speaker stated that from all the mercenary of business standpoint he could not see even one item by which the farmers would be benefited, and as a consequence many staunch Liberals had turned against their party as they saw that better prices could be obtained in their own country. He stated that Mr. Wm. Flavell, of Lindsay, had shown him a telegram from Calgary a few days ago, which stated that American eggs were being landed and were selling at a dollar a crate below the Canadian article. "If continued the colonel, the American can pay the freight and the tariff and still undersell the Canadian producers by 6c a dozen what will they do when they have no tariff wall? Why, they will swamp the market, not only in eggs but in every other article, as horses, cattle and even grain can be raised cheaper in that country."

#### COUNTRY GROWING.

"Canada at the present time is prosperous and the outlook is very brilliant. The towns are growing, and new towns and cities are growing up, and the residents of these towns and cities must be fed and who produces the article that feeds them if not the farmer? So that the increased demand will mean increased prices, and why should the Yankee be allowed to receive the benefit of Canadian industry after refusing Canada the benefit of the Yankee markets when it would have benefited her. We want to keep that steady growth, and in a few years we will have a large population, but why should we allow the Yankee to be permitted, and give him a chance to make money?"

The speaker stated that he was in the United States during the past winter and when Canadians were wearing expensive clothing to keep out the cold and housing their stock in warm stables, the Americans were having warm weather and did not have to go to this expense so that they would have another advantage over the Canadians. He also explained that the civilization of Ontario and the Dominion was much better than that in the neighboring country to the south and he asked if the Canadian boys and girls were to be subjected to the influence from that source. The Colonel wanted the boys and girls to grow up with good educations to fit them for a high place in this magnificent country.

#### UNDERSSELLING CANADA.

"To-day," continued the Colonel, "the Americans are sending sheep into Canada, paying a dollar duty and still underselling the Canadians, so that every farmer should be opposed to reciprocity. Then last year the Yankees exported more wheat than Canada raised, and it was the same with hogs so what chance would the Canadian farmer have? The official records show that a very heavy draught horse can be raised from a colt at the cost of \$30 in the States, being pastured the whole year round, while the Canadians have to care for the foal and his mother, and the records show that it costs \$100 to raise a colt three years old in Canada. In the West there is a market for

100,000 horses and why should this be thrown open to America?

He explained that the Liberals were canvassing hard, giving each class a different story trying to make them believe that each particular class would be benefited.

#### LAURIER'S UNPATRIOTISM.

The liberties we enjoy, the speaker stated, were secured from Great Britain and every loyal Canadian should fight against the annexation of Canada. Reciprocity would place Canada under the control of the trusts which exist in the United States where the price of every article is regulated by the combines. "Are we to throw aside all allegiance to the mother country after she has nursed us to maturity, only to be down trodden by the Yankee? Are we to be bought and sold to the United States and cease to be a free people?" The colonel explained that they were confident that the people would not allow this and asked that every one work hard when the answer to the Laurier government would be overwhelming. (Cheers.)

#### E. GUS PORTER, K.C.

Mr. E. Gus Porter, K.C., member for Hastings, was next called on to speak and was greeted with three rousing cheers. He stated his pleasure at being present and at Col. Hughes' nomination, and paid the Colonel some splendid compliments, stating that as a member of the Commons he was looked upon with great respect and could be relied on at all times to do the right thing. He stated that in nominating the Colonel again they had done not only that gentleman a great honor but also the country at large. He explained that in Hastings the Conservatives were standing fast and expressed his opinion that on election day a victory over Laurier would be the result and Borden and his associates in power. "Every dog has his day, and the dog days of the Laurier Government are over." He stated that the tendency of the Liberals was to overlook the history of the government on the great issue of reciprocity but gave his opinion that the people would not vote wholly on it, great as the question was as every department of the Government had a scandal. It meant a great deal he explained, when out of a cabinet of 14 not one department could be found free from graft and corruption. The head of the Government, Sir Wilfrid Laurier, he stated, did not occupy any position in the country outside of his official position as he enjoyed a reputation that any person would not like. He, (Laurier) had stated that if he had been present at the time of the rebellion in Saskatchewan he would have taken arms against the loyal Canadians and also that the whole hope of his life was to see the country separated from Britain. Laurier was the man who in 1908 asked the people to give him a chance to finish his work and what his work was they could see now—the annexation of Canada by the United States.

#### GRAFT AT OTTAWA.

The speaker went on to explain the graft in every department showing how in the Department of Finance, the Farmers Bank scandal had brought ruin to many hard working farmers. He stated that no greater billage had ever been perpetrated on any people than that by the Honorable Mr. Fielding in granting the charter to the Farmers Bank. The law, he stated, provided that before any bank should have the right to transact business in this country it should comply with certain formalities and make a bonafide deposit with the government. Fielding knew this and before the charter was granted he was warned that the Farmers Bank was a huge fraud, and received notice in writing and yet in spite of all, the charter was granted. In spite of the fact that more than one had warned him that there was no capital and the stock holders list was bogus. Fielding, explained the speaker, had all this information and knew that the whole thing was a fraud and also that the farmers would be induced to deposit their money in that bank and yet he did not stop the charter. Fielding, he stated, was the man, who, when the confederation was passed, made a motion in the Nova Scotia Legislature to break the Confederation and it looked funny that he was chosen by the leader to go to Washington and make the agreement with the United States.

#### MORE CORRUPTION.

In reference to the Inland Revenue Department the speaker stated that the head of the department had been convicted of defrauding the people of \$100,000. "He gave substantial proof of his fraud and corruption in other departments, stating that the
